

The article* from Jerry Durham, FMO Vice President and FMO Legislative Chairman, that refers to future events that are fictitious but NOT impossible!

- January 2022 In the year of their 60th anniversary, the Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida, Inc. (FMO) announced they are dissolving the corporation as they are no longer able to meet their financial and legal obligation, thus ending the only statewide advocacy group for mobile/manufactured homeowners.
- February 2022 Citizens Insurance announced they will no longer offer insurance to mobile homes older than 10 years and all carports and sheds will not be included in the coverage.
- March 2022 In a cost cutting measure, the Governor has recommended abolishing the Division of Condominiums, Timeshares and Mobile Homes, thus eliminating the DBPR.
- April 2022 New bills have been created in the upcoming Legislative Session to:
 Abolish the sales tax exemption on mobile home lot rentals
 Eliminate the funding for the Mobile Home Tie Down
 Program
 Eliminate the Florida Mobile Home Relocation Corporation.
- May 2022 Mobile Home installers no longer need to be licensed.
- June 2022 All Park Bingo Cards subject to sales tax.
- July 2022 Residents in cooperatives will lose their Homestead Exemption.
- August 2022 Mobile homes on rental property will now be taxed as real property.
- October 2022 Park owners have begun to lobby for elimination of Florida Statue 723, indicating Florida Statue 83, the Landlord-Tenant Act, should once again be the governing document for mobile homes on rental property.
- December 2022 Purchases of Mobile/Manufactured homes has seen a momentous decline and is expected to continue declining as this once affordable lifestyle has seen significant rental increases and devaluation of these homes. This once affordable alternative option to Florida Retirement is no longer viable.

If you have additional concerns or questions, please let us have them in writing. We are your voice to Sun Communities and we are working for you.

Our Library at Park Royale

ave you noticed how nice the library looks lately? Christine Biermeir (1-727-544-1971) has accepted the responsibility of keeping the library orderly and user-friendly. We all can help by following any suggestions that Christine offers.

Did you know.....

. . . . to declog your drain, you mix 1 cup of baking soda,

1 cup of salt and ½ cup of vinegar. Pour this down the drain and let it sit for 5 minutes then add ½ c. of lemon juice. After 15 minutes, pour 2 cups of boiling water down the drain to flush.

. . . . to make your own stain remover, add to spray bottle 1 part hydrogen peroxide, 1 part baking soda and 2 parts water. Apply to stain before washing.

..... you can make you own spray mop solution by mixing 4 cups of hot water, 1 cup of lemon juice, 3 cups of vinegar and ¼ cup of dish detergent liquid in a bucket. Mix thoroughly, then pour the liquid into the spray mop container.

. . . . if you run out of glass cleaner, all you have to do is combine 2 tablespoons of lemon juice, 1 tablespoon of white vinegar and 1 cup of hot water in a spray bottle. Shake and then start spritzing.






What should I bring to the Pot Luck??



Recipe of the Month

Corn Casserole

- 1 pkg. yellow rice (family size package)*
- 2 cans Mexicorn, Drained
- 1 can of mushroom soup diluted with ½ can milk
- 1 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese



Recipes

Cook rice according to directions. Mix corn, rice, soup and ½ cup of cheese. Bake in 13 x 9 inch greased casserole at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. Sprinkle remaining ½ cup of cheese on top ad return to oven for approximately 10 minutes or until cheese is melted.

*If made with small pkg. rice, use 1 can corn and only half can of soup and half cup of cheese.






