



News and Notes from the Pool Improvement Club

ow nice it is to get into the pool with the Wind Breaker off and with the tropical sun and breezes all around you!

Safety Issues

It has been noted that the dividing float-rope strung between the shallow and deep waters of the pool has been unhitched and set aside on the walk. It was found at least three times. That rope is NEVER to be removed. It is a major safety infraction and would be cause for an inspector to close down our pool. If you do that to swim laps, you need to swim under the rope. Please, if anyone sees this taking place, please politely let the person know about this forbidden by law. If you are met with insolence or disdain, give the information to a governing board member.

Please remember, we do not have Spa workers at our pool. When using the facilities for your and your GUESTS, go over all the Pool rules with them, always shower upon entering and exiting, apply your sun screen at home, not near the pool, rinse off any noodles or barbells after use and return to the utility chest. Use a towel on the lounges and chairs. If you have repositioned a chair or chase, replace them to their corrected positions on the pool deck. Remove all articles you carried in (towels, sunglasses, googles, water bottles, paper or plastic waste, etc.).

Do not have any open containers of drinks at the pool, such as cans of soda or alcoholic drinks enticing bees and flies and gnats to join us in our fun. We have to be smart about everything concerning food and drinks. We have a huge problem with rats in the neighborhood, and we do not want to lure them to our pool. We have already seen birds flying in to enjoy crumbs and they love to leave their droppings. Squirrels also enjoy cleaning up after a picnic of just about anything! There is plenty of room for food and drinks in the Pavilion Area. It is

shady and easy to get to through the aide gate, yet far enough to keep the critters away from the pool area.

Always be respectful to the property and other swimmers. We had some issues at the pool last spring, involving someone with a cut and bleeding and a child throwing up in the pool. Believe me there was even instances of feces in pool area. All these facts caused a disruption for the other Ranchers and their families, in the closure of the pool. Because of these circumstances we now have commanding rules to adhere to. If there is bleeding on the grounds or other bodily matter or fluids rendered, TAKE ACTION, OWN IT! YOU need to immediately close the pool and call a member of the governing board to conduct the proper cleaning. It may involve the Pool closing for a day or so, depending on the matter and extent of clean up.

Safety First:

So if you are ill in any way, do not enter the pool areas. Please if anyone has an open wound or feeling ill, do not come into the pool area. We need to have respect and protect our fellow Ranchers and guests from infection and disease. Avoid an accident. We all need to keep the Pool clean and safe and follow the rules listed next to the shower area. A dose of good common sense is a wonderful preventative.

Aluminum Cans:

Thank you for recycling your aluminum cans. We continue our collection year round. All the funds collected go toward the cost of the Splash party.

Splash Party:

Our Splash party this year will take place on April 6th at the Clubhouse. You do not have to brng any place settings, we have that all covered, with plastic utensils. You may bring your own silverware if you desire. It is open to all our Ranch Mobile Residents and their overnight guests. There is a cost of \$2.00 per tickets. Green Bean Casserole with Bacon

Yield: Serves 8 Prep Time: 5 minutes Cook Time: 55 minutes Total Time: 1 hour

INGREDIENTS

- 4 slices bacon, diced
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 3 tablespoons flour
- 1-1/4 cups whole milk
- 4 (14.5 oz) cans French style green beans, drained
- 1 teaspoon ground pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup French fried onions, divided
- 1 cup grated cheddar

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- 2. Add the bacon to a large skillet over medium heat and fry until crisp.
- 3. Add the garlic and cook, stirring constantly, for one minute.
- 4. Whisk in the flour until smooth and creamy.
- 5. Whisk in the milk and continue cooking, whisking constantly, until the mixture has thickened to the consistency of gravy.
- 6. Add the drained green beans to a large mixing book and pour the bacon mixture over the top. Add salt, pepper, and half of the fried onions. Still well to combine.
- 7. Spread into a greased 8x8 baking dish. Sprinkle the top with cheddar.
- 8. Bake for 35 minutes. Sprinkle the remaining onions over the top of the casserole and continue baking for 5 minutes.
- 9. Serve immediately.

You then realize just how complicated this naming process has become. And, you have many more names than you imagined. If you have a common name, the shift to no name at all is a quick, two-stage process. First your name is coupled to a partial description and then disappears entirely. Take Mike, for example. Mike, Mike, Mike, No Mike is ever, Mike. Not around here. Nancy is another name in widespread use. Lunch Lady Nancy - Nancy Fancy Pants - New Nancy - Jewelry Nancy - That Other Nancy. There's Nick, Young Nick, /soccer Nick, Bank Nick. All lose their name in rapid fashion. Do you know your name? Maybe you should find out Then again, maybe you don't want to know.




