Park squirrels found new places to bury their acorn trophies and Monarch butterflies, a joy for some to see, feasted on the Oleanders to the point of extinction. Following the holiday decorations, another choice of shrub will be replacing those lost.

Excessive flooding caused the Caladium plantings to resemble water lily gardens. That shortened their usual colorful display. Thankfully, some survived and by October appeared to multiply before taking their winter siesta.

Duke Clark tackled the arduous task of Podocarpus trimming. Bob Hebblewhite, with his carpenter and painting skills, is keeping our wood benches safe for sitting. Marcel Bedard worked to remove our long time Leland Cypress. It became a victim of deadly rust and will be replaced by a disease resistant ever-green in 2015.

Memorial donations enable us to continue having a true arboretum (a collection of unique plantings). Volunteers sharing some upkeep make everything possible!

## **CRANBERRY CHILI MEATBALLS**

1 can (14 ounces) jellied cranberry sauce

1 bottle (12 ounces) chili sauce

3/4 cup packed brown sugar

1/2 teaspoon chili powder
