

Cinnamon Christmas Brunch Cake

With Optional White Glaze

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1-1/4 cups sugar (add in more for a sweeter taste)
- 1-1/4 cups milk
- 1 2 teaspoon vanilla (optional) or 1 -2 teaspoon almond extract (optional)
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 pinch salt
- 1 large egg (optional)

TOPPING:

- 1/2 cup brown sugar (can use more or less)
- 1 -2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/4 cup melted butter
- chopped walnuts (optional) or pecans (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Set oven to 350 degrees F. Prepare a greased 13 x 8-inch baking dish, or two 8 or 9-inch round cake pans (although the batter will seem like it will fit into only one 8 or 9-inch pan, this flop rises very high ad will run over the sides if baked in just one pan).
- 2. In a bowl mix the 2 cups flour, 1-1/4 cups white sugar, milk, vanilla or almond extract, baking powder, pinch of salt and egg (if using) until just combined, careful not to over mix.
- 3. Pour into prepared baking pans.
- 4. Generously spread brown sugar and cinnamon on top.
- 5. If desired, sprinkle chopped walnuts or pecans over top.
- 6. Drizzle melted butter over top.
- 7. Bake for about 20-25 minutes for 8 or 9-inch round cake pan, and about 30 minutes for a 13 x 9-inch pan.

WHITE GLAZE (Optional)

Ingredients:

- 2 cups powdered sugar, sifted (please sift to remove any small lumps)
- 1/3 cup whipping cream (any amount to desired texture start with 1/4 cup, or use 18% table cream)
- 1-1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract or 1-1/2 teaspoons almond extract Directions:
- 1. Whisk all ingredients in a bowl adding whipping cream until desired texture is achieved (do not make it too thin or it won't stick on cakes.)

What Is It With Giving Fruitcake on Christmas?

I personally hope they don't. It would spoil my fun. Like a lot of old coots, I often find myself unsupervised in shopping center parking lots. That's when I push my panic button to silence my horn and go into the store When my wife comes along and says, "Sorry I took so long; did you get made waiting?" I smile and answer, "Of course not. I had my paper and coffee. And, you know how much I like to people watch. They really put on a show today!"

9 Things You Might Not Know About "Peanuts"

n October 2, 1950, the four-panel comic strip by 27-year-old Charles M. Schulz made its debut. Known as Peanuts, it eventually became one of the world's most widely read comic strip turning its characters - Charlie Brown, Snoopy, Linus, Lucy, Peppermint Patty and Schroeder - into American pop culture icons. Get the facts about the famous comic strip Peanuts and its creator.

1. Schulz's lifelong ambition was to be a cartoonist.

A Minnesota-born barber's son, Schulz dreamed of becoming a cartoonist from a young age. He drew constantly and read newspaper comic strips with his dad. When Schulz was 15, he published his first drawing, a picture of his dog, who later served as the inspiration for Snoopy.

2. Schulz wasn't a fan of the name Peanuts

In 1947, one of Schulz's local newspapers, the St. Paul Pioneer, started publishing a weekly comic panel he'd created called "Li'l Folks," which featured the forerunners of the Peanuts characters. In 1950, Schulz sold "Li'l Folks" to the United Feature Syndicate. Due to worries about potential copyright infringement, the syndicate opted to rechristen Schulz's comic strip Peanuts. Even after Peanuts became hugely successful, Schulz said he never liked the name and wanted to call the strip "Good Old charlie Brown."

3. The strip wasn't an instant hit.

When Peanuts made its October 1950 debut, it was published in seven U.S. newspapers. That first year, the comic strip came in last place in the New York World Telegram's reader



survey of cartoons; however, a book of Peanuts reprints helped the strip gain a larger audience. Eventually, the strip was syndicated to more than 2,600 newspapers around the globe and read by more than 350 million people in 75 countries. Schulz was also named Outstanding Cartoonist of the Year.

4. Many of the Peanuts characters were inspired by real people and events.

Snoopy was one of Schulz's earliest Peanuts characters, appearing for the first time on October 4, 1950, two days after the comic strip's debut. Schulz loosely based Snoopy on a black-and-white dog named Spike he had as a teenager. Schulz remembered his mother's suggestion that the family should name their next dog "Snoopy."

After serving in World War II, Schulz worked as an instructor at the Minneapolis correspondence school where he'd taken art classes as a teen. It was there where he befriended Charlie Brown, whose name would later become that of his main character. Also while employed at the school, Schulz became romantically involved with a redhead named Donna Johnson, who worked in the accounting department. She eventually rejected him for another man, leaving Schulz crushed. However, the experience inspired the cartoonist to develop a character called the Little Red-Haired Girl, Charlie Brown's unrequited love.

In 1968, following the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Schulz introduced his comic strip's first black character, Franklin, whose father was a soldier in the Vietnam War. Another character, a yellow bird called Woodstock, was named for the 1969 landmark music festival.

5. TV execs thought "A Charlie Brown Christmas" would flop.

Network executives expected the Christmas special to be shown once on TV and then disappear. Instead, when the program premiered on December 9, 1965, it drew a large audience. It later won an Emmy award and became one of the longest-running holiday specials of all time.

6. Snoopy went to space.

Following the 1967 Apollo I fire disaster, NASA officials contacted Charles Schulz to use Snoopy as their safety mascot. Schulz helped design a pin for the Silver Snoopy award, which was presented to aerospace workers for outstanding contributions toward safer spaceflight operations. Later, during the Apollo 10 mission, NASA dubbed the lunar module "Snoopy" and the command module "Charlie Brown."

7. Schulz was a World War II veteran

During the war, Schulz was drafted into the Army and assigned to the 20th Armored Infantry Division. Schulz later commemorated Veteran's Day and honored the anniversary of D-Day in Peanuts. He was involved in planning the National D-Day Memorial in Virginia. He once said, "I think any sensible person with a grasp of history would have to admit that D-Day was the most important day of our century."

8. The Peanuts creator died one day before his final Sunday comic strip appeared.

On February 12, 2000, the 77-year-old cartoonist died at his home in Santa Rosa, California,

9. There's a museum devoted to all things Peanuts

In 2002, the Charles M. Schulz Museum and Research Center opened in Sonoma County, California, where the cartoonist lived and worked for four decades. Among the museum's collection of Peanuts-related artwork, letters and photographs are a recreation of Schulz's work studio and a life-size wrapped Snoopy doghouse by the artist Christo. Numerous other museums, including the Louvre and the Smithsonian, has hosted Peanuts-themed exhibits.

11 Phone Battery Myths You Really Have to Stop Believing

Myth: I shouldn't keep my phone plugged in overnight

Truth: Smart technology stops your phone battery from charging after it's full. If the battery drops back down to a certain point when it's still plugged in, the phone knows to start charging again, says Sergio Flores, Electronics engineer for Samsung. "This way, even if you are charging your phone overnight, the phone battery is only being charged when it is necessary," he says.

Myth: Might as well always leave my phone on efficiency mode

Truth: Keeping your phone on low-power mode after it's charged won't harm the software, but it might lead to poorer user experience. "Phones are designed to be really flashy and give you an over-the-top experience." says Brad Nichols, a technician with technology repair service company Staymobile. "When you turn them into that efficiency mode, it gets rid of all the redundant things." Low brightness might make the screen hard to see, and you might notice the sound isn't as loud as you like. plus, apps might only check for notifications every ten minutes or so, so you won't get the instant feedback you're used to.

Myth: My phone is totally safe in a public charging port

Truth: Using a public port could put your information as risk. Unlike the typical socket you'd plug your charger into, those cords you see at restaurants and airports create an easy path to transfer data. "People don't realize they're not just a power source," says Eva Velasquez, CEO and president of Identity Theft Resource Center. "It's not like plugging your lamp into the wall,: Hackers could potentially access anything in your phone - emails, text, photos, and more. If you need to charge your phone battery in public a lot, a portable charger is a much safer option, says Velasquez.

Myth: I need to charge my new phone fully before I use it

Truth: Your phone already has some juice, and skipping that first charge won't affect its life long-term. The only reason some manufacturers suggest charging it first is to make a good first impression. By the time that new phone reaches your hand, testing and manufacturing have already drained up to half the battery. "If you expect an eight-hour battery and it lasted four hours, that's not the experience the manufacturer wants you to have," says Nichols. "Most of



the time these recommendations are to make users feel like they are getting the quality of the device they were promised."

Myth: I should charge my phone until it dies

It's better to juice up the lithium-ion battery in your phone before it reaches zero. "These kind of batteries tend to 'forget' what their full capacity level is, and so when recharged, they do not recharge to the same level as they were at the beginning," says Flores. Major brands have solved the problem for the most part, but older models might still have that issue, he says.

Myth: One app can't take up that much energy

Truth: Just one app could be sucking up a ton of your phone's battery. Sadly, one common culprit is the Facebook app. "A lot of [apps], like the Facebook app, do things in the background, even when you're not running it," says Nichols. The app is constantly checking for messages and status updates, and refreshing your feed in the background, he says. Some Android users have even reported that deleting Facebook apps helped their other apps run 15 percent faster and saved 20 percent of their phones' battery lives. Keep from running to your charger as often by deleting the app and checking Facebook through a web browser on your phone instead, suggests Nichols.

Myth: Turning my phone off is totally useless

Truth: Resetting your phone could help conserve battery. Most people don't fully close apps when they're done using them, so those apps are still working in the background. Each one might not use a ton of juice, but the more that are running, the shorter your battery life will be. If you're in the habit of leaving apps up, make a point of turning your phone off at least once a week to close those battery suckers. "Restarting your phone takes two minutes, and you can usually tell the difference," says Nichols. :If you turn your phone off completely, it's processing zero tasks as opposed to 20 tasks every ten minutes." Keeping it off overnight might not be realistic, so try shutting it down before a long meeting or at the movies.

Myth: I should touch my phone while it's plugged in

Truth: You can feel free to open apps or take calls while your phone is charging. "Although when you are charging your phone, the power is different from the one you normally use (the battery), the results and performance of the circuitry are always the same," says Flores. One caveat: Open apps use up power while the phone battery is charging, meaning it will take longer to juice up, says Nichols. So if you need a full charge fast, fiddling with your phone will work against you.

Myth: I should save money with an off-brand charger

Truth: Knockoff chargers could damage your phone's battery. "Cheaper chargers don't necessarily have the standards in place to fill your phone constantly with the correct voltage," says Nichols. "The fluctuation of voltage can damage the charger port, and even damage your battery." In a pinch, an off-brand cord probably won't do as much damage as a knockoff of the piece that plugs into the wall or car might. But your best bet is to stick with manufacturer-certified products, says Nichols. This is why cold weather kills your phone battery.

Myth: There's no point in hitting "eject"

Truth: Taking your phone out of your computer without ejecting it could damage your files. "If you were before transferring pictures or data, unplugging it may disrupt that connection too soon," says Nichols. You could end up with corrupted files or keep your phone from backing up completely, he says. But if your phone is plugged in to the wall, you can pull the plug any time.


Myth: Having Wi-Fi searching is killing my battery

Truth: Searching for WI-Fi does take energy, but not enough to notice. When your phone is set up to hunt for Wi-Fi, it searches for signals from access points and sends out its own signals to let them know it's there. But that doesn't mean you need to turn Wi-Fi off every time you leave the house. "You're talking about very low tasks," says Nichols. "They're not taking up much battery at all."



Coldest place in the world

The National Geographic website reports that satellite data have identified an ice sheet in the middle of the southern continent with a temperature of minus 144 degrees Fahrenheit. This breaks the previous record for the chilliest place on the globe—minus 128 degrees, recorded in 1983 at the Russian Vostok Station close to the South Pole.
