

Bacon Wrapped Cream Cheese Stuffed Chicken Breast

Ingredients:

- 2 Boneless skinless chicken breast
- 4 tablespoons cream cheese
- 1 1/4 cup Pepper jack cheese, shredded
- 2 tablespoons green onion, chopped
- 4 to 8 pieces of bacon

Cut chicken into 4 equal size pieces. Pound breast so it is about 1/4" thick.

Mix together softened cream cheese, chopped green onions and shredded pepper jack cheese. Put 1/4 of this mixture into the middle of each piece of chicken.

Starting at the long side, roll chicken breast up, keeping the cheese mixture to the middle.

Wrap 1 to 2 slices of bacon around the chicken breast, secure with toothpick, if needed.

One piece of bacon wrapped around each breast is enough. But 2 pieces of bacon for each breast fully wraps the chicken and is outstanding.

Place on baking sheet and back for 30 minutes at 375 degrees F.

Broil topside for about 5 minutes to fully brown and crisp bacon. Turn each breast over and broil for another 3 minutes or so to crisp up the bottom side.

CHOCOLATE PECAN CHEESECAKE PIE

- 1 Deep Dish Pie Shell
- 1 cup Dark Chocolate Chips
- 3 Tbsp. Whipping Cream
- 8oz. Cream Cheese
- 3/4 cup Sugar divided (1/2 cup & 1 1/4 cup)
- 2 tsp. Vanilla
- 4 Eggs
- 1/4 tsp. Salt
- 3 Tbsp. Melted butter
- 1 cup Light Corn Syrup
- 1 1/2 cups Pecan Halves

Directions:

- 1. Fill pie plate with crust or defrost frozen deep dish crust
- 2. Beat cream cheese, 1 egg, 1/2 c. sugar, salt and 1 teaspoon of vanilla until smooth.
- 3. Pour dark chocolate chips into microwaveable dish and add the whipping cream. Microwave on 50% power until morsels just start to melt (about 1 minute). Remove from microwave and stir with a fork until combined and smooth.
- 4. Pour corn syrup, melted butter, 3 eggs, I teaspoon vanilla and 1/4 cup of sugar into medium bowl and whisk until thoroughly combined. Stir in pecans.
- 5. Pour chocolate mixture into pie crust and smooth out with a spatula until evenly distributed. Pour cream cheese mixture over chocolate and smooth out until evenly distributed, then pour pecan mixture over cream cheese mixture and even out on top of the cream cheese mixture.
- 6. Bake in a preheated 350 degree oven for 55 minutes (or until set). Cool completely on a wire rack. Store leftovers (if you have any)in refrigerator.



Early riser vs. nighthawk: Who's better off?

Are you the early bird who gets the worm, or a night owl burning the midnight oil? The answer may have an impact on your health—and even your career.

One study cited in U.S. News & World Report found that teens who are early to bed and early to rise tend to be in better health than their peers who stay up late and sleep in, even if they get the same amount of sleep. And other studies suggest that morning people do better at resisting fatigue, anxiety, and depression, while nighthawks appear to suffer higher rates of insomnia and ADHD. The stay-up-late crowd may also have a higher propensity for substance abuse, addictive behaviors, and mental health problems.

But being a night owl has its advantages, too. Research also indicates that they can have higher IQs, more stamina during the day, better reasoning and analytical skills, and greater creativity and productivity. These traits, along with an inclination toward more risk-taking, seem to contribute to night owls having a higher average level of financial and career success.

The Mayo Clinic website notes that our sleeping habits are governed by the body's natural 24-hour cycle, known as the circadian rhythm. Some people have a slightly longer light-to-dark ratio, making them night owls; others with a short cycle tend to be early risers. However, the cycle can shift over a person's lifetime: Young children are usually early birds, then become nighthawks as teenagers, then gradually transition back to being morning people as adults.




