# **RMP Arboretum Report Fall 2019**

Real ARBORETUM: A place with plants, trees and shrubs. Unique for over twenty years is our welcoming mascot, Mr. Pumpkin Head, who lights up the Palm Tree path. If Mr. Pumpkin Head had a voice he might say,, "This 2019 year I have a renewed viewpoint. Paul Thibault, Park Maintenance Supervisor, made arrangements for Park Employees to re-do my raised bed surround using pressure treated planks. With improved garden soil, volunteers planted Pelagonium citrosum, commonly referred to as "Mosquito Shoo Geranium." Their lacelike foliage has a distinctive lemony scent. Hopefully, these geraniums will discourage mosquitos and make sitting nearby a pleasant experience. Opposite me on a knoll I see a metal silhouette of Dandelion Girl given in memory of Helga Frank, a long time Arboretum advocate. Beside her is a new Red Cardinal steel bench facing my patio and blue bird bath observation area."

Thanks to Ranch Avenue neighbor, Bob Hebblewhite who keeps our benches safe and painted as they weather, and to Hobby Club members who gave colorful new life to our garden sculptures, with a touch of whimsy to some.

Mr. Pumpkin Head did have a short summer siesta when the Park Board had Matthew's install an underground sprinkler system and Dunedin Electric update the below ground electric wiring.

Joint efforts from Joanne Cook and Wilma Gardner planted six dwarf evergreen perennials around the Sean Road Bird of Paradise. The plants are a hybrid developed in England and are named Raspberry Swirl Dianthus.

Janet Maxwell and Mike Higbie replaced a former Ranch Road Caladium circle with a pale green Butternut Shrub which is an evergreen and expected to bear white blossoms. The pineapples behind the Palm Tree Path are ones Jan and Mike planted and monitor.

Altogether, we have five different Hibiscus. Two are new this year along Hawthorn Lane. Joanne planted an anonymous donation of a large Tropical Salmon Hibiscus. Wilma planted a



gift of a spectacular red Hibiscus donated by Marg and Iain Maciver.

After the 50th Anniversary palm succumbed to disease, George Haynor Nursery planted for us a variety of Shrimp Shrub. It is an evergreen with bright yellow blooms.

Two sun loving perennial Yuccas are replacements this year. One is visible near the corner of Swan Road and Ranch Avenue and the other is in the area of the corner of three Queen Palms. The Yucca fronds are striped gold and green. by midsummer 2020 we should see bunches of white bell-shaped blossoms.

All the annuals in he Arboretum flower gardens were chosen and being cared for by Wilma Gardner. Her other special project are several Hostas. Since the glass birdbath has been moved to the midst of her garden by the Pavilion entrance, small birds are frequent visitors. Large Black Birds, Blue Jays and Doves each claim their time at the other three birdbaths. Squirrels wait their turn and Rabbits find droplets left by the sprinkler system. We truly have a Wildlife Sanctuary.

Joanne continues caring for the two very large Powder Puff shrubs. Blooming time for them coincides with our winter holiday season. One is white and the other is red.

One by one, seasonal volunteers will be returning when the Staghorns, Cycads, Bird of Paradise, Orchids and Oak trees will benefit with their attention. Marcel Bedard, Linda Raimondi, Dennis Gray, Marcia Peterson, Chick House, Sandy Barrow, Marg Maciver, along with Mike Higbie help make our Arboretum part of our wonderful world. Hope you enjoy having this park area within our Ranch Mobile Home Park. I look forward to your stopping by. Tours are always "free" and a welcome weeding break for me. Your comments and questions are important and help me make RMP the best place to be. Hope to see you soon!

ant to handle your money better? Most of us do. The Motley Fool website advises breaking these three bad habits:

- Paying bills late. A few days or weeks may not seem to matter, but you'll be hit with late fees, interest, and damage to your credit rating. Do your best to pay all your bills on time. Set up reminders so you're always on schedule. Automatic payment is one reliable option.
- Accumulating too much debt. Not all debt is bad, as long as you manage it sensibly and pay it off in a reasonable time. If you can't pay off your credit cards and other debt by the end of the month, set up a budget that helps you monitor and control your spending before debt gets out of control and hurts your credit rating.
- **Not saving.** Putting money away can be difficult, but not saving any money is a mistake. You should have a reasonable cushion in case of emergencies—at least three months' worth of living expenses. Look for ways to cut costs, and set up a separate savings account so you're able to keep track of savings and spending money easily.

# When and where to pay cash

redit and debit cards are convenient, but sometimes you're better off using cash. The Reader's Digest website suggests keeping your card in your wallet in these situations:

- **Tipping.** Tipping in cash instead of adding it to your bill ensures that your server gets the full amount.
- Farmer's markets. Many vendors have credit card machines nowadays, but not all of them. And the machines can always go down because of a power outage or spotty Wi-Fi. Keep cash handy so you don't miss out.
- Minimum purchases. Coffee shops and other venues frequently have a \$5 or \$10 minimum for credit card purchases. Paying cash ensures you don't buy more than you need in order to meet the minimum.
- **Private transactions.** You want to buy a special gift for your spouse, but you don't want him or her seeing it on a credit card statement. Use cash to keep the transaction secret.

# Brainstorming isn't the only solution

un fact: The man who popularized brainstorming in the 1940s also touted the benefits of solitude when searching for creative ideas. Alex Osborn's book, Your Creative Power, described how he brought a practice he'd seen in a previous job to the advertising firm BBD&O (he's the "O").

"The early participants dubbed our efforts 'Brainstorm Sessions,' and quite aptly so," the book says, "because, in this case, 'brainstorm' means using the brain to storm a creative problem—and do so in commando fashion, with each stormer attacking the same objective."

But he also advised solo thinking. "A good long shower or a hot tub often induces ideas. One reason is that while we bathe we are shut off from distracting influences." And he describes one particularly fruitful effort:

"Once when I faced a hard creative task, I went to an inn over 100 miles away. Not only was I uninterrupted—not only did I get away

from routine—but, because I had made such effort to go so far solely to engage in creative effort, my imagination seemed to work far better. The very taking of that trip tended to sharpen my imagination."

Brainstorming can be useful, but it's not the only tactic for sparking your creativity.

# An alphabetical guide to inspiration

s creativity as simple as ABC? Harvey Mackay thinks so. The businessman and bestselling author shared his formula for innovation and inspiration in a column on the Daily Herald website. Here's how his list begins:

- A: Advertising. "Expand your brand beyond media-generated advertising. For example, we painted our company name and phone numbers on top of our delivery trucks so they were visible to people who worked on upper floors of tall buildings."
- **B: Bold.** "People are not inspired by ordinary messages, so give them a reason to remember you."
- C: Curious. "Curiosity may not have been good for the cat, but it's a winning formula for people."
- **D: Different.** "Don't be afraid to do things that have never been tried before. You have to have enough faith in yourself to trust your instincts."
- **E: Everyone.** "I firmly believe that everyone has the capacity to be creative, if only they allow themselves to be."

# Add more plant-based foods to your diet for better heart health

Ven if you're not a vegetarian, this information may come in handy. According to the Science Daily website, a new study suggests that cutting back on animal-based foods and eating more plant-based foods may lead to a healthier heart.

Researchers analyzed data on food intake from more than 10,000 middle-aged adults in the United States who participated in a study from 1987 through 2016. None of them had any cardiovascular disease at the outset of the study. The researchers looked at the proportion of plant-based food the participants ate compared to animal-based foods. Those who ate the most plant-based meals had a 16% lower risk of cardiovascular disease (heart attack, stroke, heart failure, and other conditions), a 32% lower risk of dying from a cardiovascular disease, and a 25% lower risk of death in general compared with those who ate the least amount of plant-based food.

Meanwhile, another study reported on the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Health website suggests that a plant-based diet may help ward off type 2 diabetes. Researchers looked at data from nine studies that included health data from more than 300,000

participants, of whom 23,544 had type 2 diabetes. Their review of adherence to an overall predominant- ly plant-based diet found that people with the highest adherence had a 23% lower risk of type 2 diabetes than those with weaker adherence to the diets.

You may not have to go completely vegan, but cutting out meat and eating more fruits, vegetables, legumes, and whole grains can have a positive effect on your physical well-being.


o you read a lot? If so, chances are you're more kind and empathetic than most people, according to a study reported on the Peace Quarters website.

- Don't wear loose sleeves or loose clothing when cooking.
- Keep anything that can catch on fire—pot holders, oven mitts, towels, etc.—away from your stovetop or oven.
- Turkey fryers are extremely dangerous, and most safety organizations do not recommend their use.
- Make sure you have a smoke alarm installed with working batteries. Push the button to check that it's working every month, and install new batteries at least once a year.
- After your guests leave, do a home safety check to make sure that all candles are extinguished and all of your cooking appliances are turned off.


