





MESSAGE FROM THE MANAGER

ERRY CHRISTMAS to one and all from the management and staff of Ranchero Village. We wish you all, whether here or away, a wonderful Christmas filled with the true joy of the season.

The staff will be off December 24th and 25th (Thursday and Friday) so the office will be closed both days and there will be NO GARBAGE pick-up that Friday.

(And, planning ahead, the staff will be off for New Year's Day so the office will be closed Friday, January 1.) There will be NO GARBAGE pick-up on that Friday either.

In case of a Park related after hour's emergency, please call 346-4819.

POOL CLOSURE

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding during the time the Hacienda Pool has been closed.

GARBAGE

Trash must be out by 8:00am or it may not be picked up. The trash route has changed so you cannot go by the old schedule. They will NOT be looping back around.

If it was not out on time you will need to take it to the maintenance yard or store it until the next trash or recycling pick up day.

When taking your garbage to the maintenance yard to dispose of it yourself, please observe the signs on the various receptacles and only put garbage in the proper location. Kitchen waste goes into the containers marked for KITCHEN WASTE. Yard waste as well as construction materials, shower pans, 2x4's, furniture, etc., goes into the large roll offs. Everything is clearly marked for your convenience. Thank you for your help in this matter.

Also, please do not put your trash out the night before. It must be out by 8:00am but not over night.

ROSE TREE GATE:

If you use the Rose Tree Gate please be sure to lock it each time you go through. The lock is there to help keep non-Ranchero residents out.

DON'T MAKE A TERRIBLE MISTAKE WHEN RENTING OR SELLING!!!!

Always check with the office BEFORE selling or renting your home to anyone. Even if the buyers or renters have previously lived or rented in Ranchero, or are currently living here, they still need to go through the proper procedures and be approved by the manager **BEFORE** the rental or sale is finalized. Just because they have been here before does not necessarily mean they have been approved for purchase. **If a sale is NOT approved by management, the** "seller" of the home will continue to be held responsible for the home and any expenses incurred. DO NOT sign your home titles over to anyone until you have park approval.

Both long term and short term occupants of a home, whether a renter, an owner, or an additional occupant are required to have a background check run. Anyone staying in Ranchero Village as more than a guest of 15 days up to twice a year is required to have a background check. This rule applies to everyone. If you have been here before but have had an absence of over two years you will be required to have a current background check run. These rules apply to everyone.

WATER BILLING QUESTIONS FROM AFAR

If you get a water bill that you question while you are away from Ranchero Village, please contact the office so we can check the meter and re-read it. Also the person who is watching your home right away and have them go in and make sure there are no leaks, the hot water heater is turned off and the water valves are all closed. Have they been watering the lawn or doing anything around the home that requires water. It is so important to have someone watching your home and inspecting it regularly to make sure there are no problems.

If the caregiver says the house is okay and does not find a cause for the bill, then contact the community office and we will have a reread done on the water meter to try to determine the cause of the problem. Sometimes it is just a reading or data entry error, but many times toilets, water heaters and water softeners are the culprits that send water usage through the roof. They are the sneaky leaks that leave no trail but can be extremely expensive.

One way to check for leaks is by placing food coloring in the upper tank of your toilet. If it seeps down into the toilet bowl, you have a leak. Another way to check for household leaks is record your water meter level before and after a two-hour period of no water use. If the meter increases over the time period, you have a leak.

FLAG

If there is a problem with the flag at the Corral Clubhouse, please call the community office and we will have it taken care of. Do not try to fix it yourself.

POOL RULES

All the rules for the pool apply to all people at all times. The rules posted as well as those which we highlight in this Bulletin are to be followed at all hours and conditions. Just because no one else is at the pool when you are, does not mean the rules can be altered for your convenience. For example: If no one else is at the pool you must still abide by the No Smoking Rule and only smoke in the designated area. Another example is: the children's hours remain the same whether or not others are there. These are just examples, but you get the idea. Let's all keep the rules and keep Ranchero a pleasant place to live and enjoy.

HOT TUB USE IS FOR ADULTS ONLY.

No one under 18. <u>Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub</u>. The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, <u>no longer than 15 minutes</u>. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores.

<u>GLASS BOTTLES</u> – PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.

<u>No smoking at the pools</u> – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas.

TREE PERMITS

Permits MUST be obtained from the City of Largo for the removal of any tree with a trunk larger than 4" in diameter. Certain trees will require a fee before the permit can be obtained. The community office must submit the request to the City.

If you have gone through the permit process and have removed a tree please contact the community office and let us know so we can have the permit closed out with the City.

PUT IT IN WRITING!

All requests and complaints should be put in writing and signed. Anonymous reports will not be addressed. Forms are available in the office for your convenience

HANDICAP CHAIR LIFT

If you need assistance to go into a pool, we have a Handicap Chair Lift available at the Hacienda swimming pool.

STREET LIGHT OUT

Unknown to many, our streetlights do not belong to us. They are the property of Duke Energy and maintained by them. If a light is out please: Call Duke Energy @ 1-800-228-8485.

WATER SHUT-OFFS

The water is scheduled to be shut off for maintenance repairs <u>IF NEEDED</u> on Tuesdays, from approximately 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. (weather permitting). It is handy to keep a gallon of water on hand for these days and remember to <u>turn off your hot water heater</u>.

NO LEFT TURNS AT THE BELCHER GATE

Please obey the no left turn sign at the Belcher Gate. This is an illegal turn. It can cost you several hundred dollars in fines. A Traffic Control officer stopped by the office to respond to complaints and said they may be monitoring this so please obey the rules and be safe.






