



# **NEEDLES AND SYRINGES:**

Please dispose of all medical waste appropriately. If you are using syringes, please do not put them in the bag where someone can get stabbed with one. It is a major health concern.

If you do not have a box for disposing "sharps", you can put them in a bottle and put the cover on so they don't cause a problem.

# **DON'T FORGET TO SIGN IN:**

Please remember to sign in at the office so we can update our records.

# **BUZZZZZZZZZZZ**

If you are having trouble with bees, please **<u>DO NOT</u>** try to exterminate them yourself. Call the community office for referrals if needed but do not try to spray them. Bees can be very dangerous and if the hive is Africanized it can be easily riled. Professional help is a must!!!

# ONE WAY IS FOR BOTH CARS AND BICYCLES, GOLF CARTS, ETC.

I strongly urge residents to obey the one way arrows in the roads, especially around the clubhouses. Those following the correct direction of the arrows are not looking for those going the wrong way. We have seen many instances where someone has almost gotten run over because of someone going against the arrows. This applies to everyone, whether in car, truck, golf cart, bicycle, etc. And backing out is not approved just because the vehicle is facing the correct direction. We have some creative offenders!! Thank you for your cooperation in this safety measure.

# **KEYS**

If you are leaving a position as officer of one of the organizations in the community, remember to return your keys to the Key Coordinator.

# **MESSY CONTRACTORS**

Even though it may be a contractor doing the work on your house, it is still your responsibility to make sure that his mess is cleaned up and not left in the yard or street. You will be held responsible for any damage left by the people doing work for you.

Contractors are also required to take all debris and trash with them and not put it in the dumpsters at the maintenance yard. If you are doing your own work, please see the office for a Permit to dump your debris.



#### "FOR SALE"

Any items left at the end of driveways and marked as "for sale" will be confiscated as garbage. The annual carport sale will be in February and you are welcome to sell things that day.

#### **MAILBOX FLAGS**

The flags by the mailboxes at the Lakes and Hacienda Clubhouses are to be left down and only <u>raised by the Mail Carrier</u>. The mail person will raise the flag after delivering the mail, to signal that it has arrived. (The flags <u>are not</u> like rural mailbox flags which are raised to signal the carrier to pick up the out going mail. These signal in-coming mail.)

# **RENTERS**

It is the responsibility of the homeowners to make sure that any additional occupants in their homes are properly registered with the park. If you are planning to rent out your home or have someone stay with you, review your Ranchero **Rules and Regulations** first.

Additional occupants and renters must be registered with the office and a background check performed prior to their arrival. It is the Homeowners responsibility to meet all the requirements. There is an application fee to cover this expense. Applications are available in the Office. They must be accompanied by two legible forms of identification for each person. For international applicants, copies of passports and driver's licenses are required. These should be submitted at least 30 days in advance of the person's arrival. Renters are to check in at the office upon arriving in the community.

IF YOU ARE A RENTER OR ADDITIONAL OCCUPANT and haven't done the above, please come to the office immediately and get properly registered. Thank You!

PET RESTRICTIONS MUST BE OBSERVED BY ALL AND APPROVED BY MANAGEMENT BEFORE A PET CAN BE BROUGHT INTO THE COMMUNITY.

# **GUESTS**

# Guests staying more than 1 Week MUST be registered in the Community Office.

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool.

Guest pool tags are available in the office for a \$2.00 deposit each.

**GOOD MORNING/GOOD EVENING** signs are still available in the office for those who live alone and would benefit by having their friends/neighbors see a sign that all is well with them.

# Did you know that December is also...

**Buckwheat Month.** Designated the "December Grain of the Month" by the Whole Grains Council, buckwheat contains higher levels of zinc, copper, and manganese than other cereal grains, along with a very high level of protein. It's used in soba noodles, crepes, blintzes, pancakes, and other delicious foods.

**National Impaired Driving Prevention Month.** This holiday season, make sure to plan for a safe way home, especially if your plans involve alcohol. If someone you know is drinking, don't let that person get behind the wheel. Remember, too, that just because you're driving sober, others on the road may not be. Always buckle up, drive with caution, and call 911 to report a suspected drunken driver.

**Safe Toys and Gifts Month.** Prevent Blindness America has declared December Safe Toys and Gifts Awareness Month, encouraging gift-givers to consider whether the toys they plan on giving suit the age and individual skills and abilities of the child who will receive them—especially for children under age 3.

**Universal Human Rights Month.** This month commemorates the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations on Dec. 10, 1948. Driven by the human tragedy of World War II, this document represents the first global expression of human rights.



National Handwashing Awareness Week, Dec. 4-10. Remember these four principles of hand awareness to stay healthy: Wash your hands when they're dirty and before eating; don't cough into your hands; don't sneeze into your hands; and avoid putting your fingers into your eyes, nose, or mouth.

Older Driver Safety Awareness Week, Dec. 5-9. Promoting greater understanding of the importance of mobility and transportation so older adults can remain active in the community by shopping, working, or volunteering—with the confidence that lack of transportation options will not strand them at home.

Computer Science Education Week, Dec. 5-11. Computer Science Education Week (CSEdWeek) is an annual program dedicated to inspiring K-12 students to take an interest in computer science. CSEdWeek is held in recognition of the birthday of computing pioneer Adm. Grace Murray Hopper (December 9, 1906).



**Kwanzaa, Dec. 26-Jan. 1.** A weeklong celebration held in the United States and in other nations honoring African heritage in African-American culture, culminating in feasts and gift giving. Kwanzaa was created by Maulana Karenga and was first celebrated in 1966–67.
