### GUESTS

#### <u>uests staying more than 1 week MUST be registered in the Community Office.</u>

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool.

#### HOT TUB USE is for adults only.

No one under 18. <u>Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub.</u> The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, <u>no longer than 15 minutes</u>. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. <u>Never</u> swim alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores.

### **STOP SIGNS**

Please stop at all STOP signs in the Park. Cars, and bicycles, continue to roll through them and someone could easily get hurt one day. Just please pay attention.

### DRIVEWAYS

There have been several 'close calls' with residents backing out and not looking.

### **RULES REVIEW OF THE MONTH:**

IX. 4. Parking regulations at Home Sites:

(a) The number of motor vehicles allowed per Home Site, excluding guest vehicles, shall be limited to space available to safely park in the carport. Residents of the Community prior to the incorporation of these rules shall be exempt. Homes with more than one vehicle must park the larger vehicle in the carport.

#### 

(b) The maximum number of motor vehicles per Home shall not exceed two (2).

(c) No parking on the grass at Home Sites.

(d) Future modification of the carport to reduce the parking capacity will not result in the Resident having the right to park the additional vehicle in the street.

f you have any problems with the landscaping or mowing, please contact the Ranchero office and not the mowing crew. The office will contact their managers and get the situation resolved as quickly as possible. There is a form for you to fill out at the office.

### TREE PERMITS

ermits MUST be obtained from the City of Largo for the removal of any tree with a trunk larger than 4" in diameter. Certain trees will require a fee before the permit can be obtained. The community office must submit the request to the City.


