

Even if someone is already a resident or a renter in Ranchero Village the office needs to be notified and certain criteria will need to be met. This is very important. Please make sure the sale will be approved before it has been finalized

BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR RENTERS AND RESIDENTS

Both long term and short term occupants of a home, whether a renter, an owner, or an additional occupant are required to have a background check run. Anyone staying in Ranchero Village as more than a guest of 15 days up to twice a year is required to have a background check run. This rule applies to **everyone**. If you have been here before but have had an absence of over two years you will be required to have a current background check run. These rules apply to everyone no matter what your past occupation may have been.

PARKING IN SOMEONE ELSE'S CARPORT

If you are leaving and are allowing someone else to park in your driveway or carport in your absence, please notify the office so that we can make a note in your file.

Also, if you must park in the street, please be courteous to your neighbors and don't block their driveways or park directly in front of their home.

DOG WALKING

All dog walkers be sure to walk your pet only in the dog section and only on the side of the street designated as dog section. Many streets are designated "dog section" on one side of the street, but the other side is not in the dog section. Keep your neighbors happy and obey the pet rules. And, of course, don't forget the 'Litter" bag.

CAUTION

An email has been sent to many of our residents claiming to be from friends in Ranchero who are in trouble in another country and are in desperate need of financial help because their money and credit cards have been stolen. Various names have been used in this scam. Please do not reply to these emails. This is a common scam which has taken advantage of many fine caring people. It is a hoax.

A similar scam is sent out by phone. Often the callers say they are calling on behalf of your

grandchild who is in trouble in another country. Check your facts before doing anything. So often our hearts rule our heads and we react before thinking it through. Sadly, some have been robbed because of their loving hearts.

Still another method of stealing your money exists. This one comes by mail. The companies, such as **Florida Water Works**, appear at first glance to be utility companies which are doing routine water quality checks. They are actually selling very expensive water filter systems. You do not need to fill in their little forms and return them. Just drop it in your recycling.

Also, the **IRS** will **NEVER** call you about anything. Please use caution whenever you are speaking with anyone who has called you asking for your information.

STOP SCAMMERS COLD

A tip from Pinellas County advises us that when we are thinking of hiring a company to do work on our homes to do a little research first. To help protect yourself, contact Pinellas County's Department of Justice and Consumer Services where you can search for a company's complaint history and learn valuable tips to make your repair experience a good one. Info: www.pinellascounty.org/consumer or call (727) 464-6200

DOOR TO DOOR SALES

Call the Largo Police Department (727-587-6730) immediately and please notify the community office if you have a solicitor come to your door. Even if you think you can just send them away with no harm, please remember they will be preying on your neighbors. Be a good neighbor and help to get rid of these predators. If a solicitor tells you they have received permission from the office to be in the park, do not believe it. Management NEVER gives permission for solicitation.

GUESTS

Guests staying more than 1 week MUST be registered in the Community Office.

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct.

No running, jumping or diving into the pool. This includes adults!

Children under the age of 16 are allowed only in the Corral Pool between the hours of 10:00am-2:00pm and 4:00pm-7:00pm or sunset whichever is later.

HOT TUB USE is for adults only.

No one under 18. <u>Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub</u>. The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, <u>no longer than 15 minutes</u>. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. <u>Never</u> swim alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if



you have wounds or open sores.

GLASS BOTTLES

PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.

No smoking at the pools

Please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas. This includes Vapor and E-cigarettes.

POOL TAGS

Please have your Pool Tags with you when you are at any of the Pools, Laundry Rooms Fitness Center or Billiards room. There will be random checks for tags.

If you need a guest tag, they can be obtained in the office for a deposit fee of \$2.00 each.

TRASH AND RECYCLING:

Please put trash and recycling out by 8:00am but not overnight. It needs to be at the end of the carport so the crew can see it.

All trash must be in bags and tied. They will not pick up loose trash.

Just a reminder that no plastic bags should be put in with Recycling.

TREE PERMITS

Permits MUST be obtained from the City of Largo for the removal of any tree with a trunk larger than 4" in diameter. Certain trees will require a fee before the permit can be obtained. The community office must submit the request to the City.

If you have gone through the permit process and have removed a tree please contact the community office and let us know so we can have the permit closed out with the City.

GET PERMISSION FIRST

Driveways, siding, roof-overs, windows, painting, planting, you name it! If you are making any type of change to the outside of your home, please come into the office first to apply for a permit. Submit your written request and wait until you have received approval and a permit before proceeding with any work. If work is started without the proper permits, management will put a stop to the work and in some cases, even demand removal. Don't put yourself or your contractor through the inconvenience of interrupted work just because you failed to follow the rules. Also, very important, be sure to obtain any required City permits.

PUT IT IN WRITING!

All requests and complaints should be put in writing and signed. Anonymous reports will not be addressed. Forms are available in the office for your convenience

Balance your internal 'thinker' and 'doer' to bring ideas to life

- Search for data. Be on the lookout for all the information you can gather about the problem you're trying to solve—and about your organization and industry. The more facts you have, the better the creative decisions you'll make.


