

RECYCLING


All cardboard boxes must be broken down or they will not be picked up. Do not put plastic bags, tissues, or paper towels in with the recycling.



If you have any problems with the landscaping or mowing, please contact the Ranchero office and not the mowing crew. The office will contact their managers and get the situation resolved as quickly as possible.

Lawn Maintenance Guidelines

Lawn Maintenance is not responsible for:

- a. Down spouts
- b. Any exposed wire that are not protected with conduit
- c. Vinyl fence
- d. Garden Hoses (All Garden Hoses must be off the grass.)
- e. Misc. items in grass. (All Misc. items must be in approved flowerbeds.)
- f. Solar garden lights (All Solar garden light must be in approved flowerbeds.)
- g. Flowerpots (All Flowerpots must be in approved flowerbeds)
- h. Wet grass

Weed whacking

- a. All homes with vinyl siding to the ground must have a 6" buffer around homes; Homeowner will be responsible for maintaining the 6-inch buffer.
- b. Management or Lawn Maintenance will not be responsible for any damages.

Blowing - Most carports, all sidewalks will be blown into the street.

The following will not be blown:

- a. Carport if full of Misc. items
- b. Back patio

Edging - as needed

- a. To 1st post of the carports
- b. Along streets
- c. Sidewalks

General information:

- a. Recycling bins should be placed on driveway or sidewalk, not on grass.
- b. Management and lawn maintenance are not responsible for trees and bushes in grass area.
- c. No mow signs should only be placed out on Wednesdays and removed Wednesday night.
- d. Less obstacles makes it more efficient for lawn maintenance.
- e. If you wish, vehicles can be parked at the clubhouses during grass cutting hours.

RENTERS

It is the responsibility of the homeowners to make sure that any additional occupants in their homes are properly registered with the park. If you are planning to rent out your home or have someone stay with you, review your Ranchero Rules and Regulations first. PET RESTRICTIONS MUST BE OBSERVED BY ALL AND APPROVED BY MANAGEMENT BEFORE A PET CAN BE BROUGHT INTO THE COMMUNITY.

Additional occupants and renters must be registered with the office and a background check performed prior to their arrival. It is the Homeowners responsibility to meet all the requirements. There is an application fee to cover this expense. Applications are available in the Office. They must be accompanied by two legible forms of identification for each person. For international applicants, copies of passports and driver's licenses are required. These should be submitted at least 30 days in advance of the person's arrival. Renters are to check in at the office upon arriving in the community.

IF YOU ARE A RENTER OR ADDITIONAL OCCUPANT and haven't done the above, please come to the office immediately and get properly registered. Thank You! <u>GUESTS</u>

Guests staying more than 1 week MUST be registered in the Community Office.

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool.

GOOD MORNING/GOOD EVENING signs are still available in the office for those who live alone and would benefit by having their friends/neighbors see a sign that all is well with them.

FALL MEANS FALLING FRUIT!!

Please pick up all the fruit off the ground so we don't have rotting fruit and unwanted guests. And be sure to have someone care for your yard if you will be away.

HOT TUB USE is for adults only.

No one under 18. <u>Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub.</u> The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, no longer than 15 minutes. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores.

<u>STOP SIGNS</u> – please stop at all STOP signs in the Park. Especially at the Becher and Ulmerton exits. Cars, golf carts and bicycles continue to roll through them and now someone has had a serious accident. Just please pay attention.

<u>DRIVEWAYS</u> – When backing out of your driveway, please stop and look before entering the street. There have been several 'close calls' with residents backing out and not looking.

<u>I strongly urge residents</u> to obey the one way arrows in the roads, especially around the clubhouses. Those following the correct direction of the arrow are not looking for those going the wrong way. We have seen many instances where someone has almost gotten run over because of someone going against the arrows.

GOLF CARTS

Golf carts are to only be driven by persons 18 years of age or older per Ranchero Rules and Regulations.

SOLICITORS

<u>DO NOT let them into your home!</u> <u>Call the Largo Police Department (587-6730)</u> <u>immediately</u> if you see solicitors and please let the management office know after you have called the police. We have been trying to catch and trespass them. If we can even get a license plate number it would help immensely. Management has been working with the police in an attempt to stop these offenders. Ranchero is a plainly posted No Soliciting Community; no one should be coming to your door. These people are very bold and brazen; please help us stop them and any other solicitors before they take advantage of anyone else in our community.

<u>GLASS BOTTLES</u> – PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.

<u>No smoking at the pools</u> – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas. This includes vapor and e-cigarettes.

HOME SITE ALTERATIONS

If you are making any changes or additions to your home site or the exterior of your home please come to the office and submit a completed request form. Paint colors must be approved and a permit obtained from the office. The same applies to alteration requests; this includes plantings. Submit your written request and wait until you have received approval and a permit before proceeding with any work. Also, be sure to obtain any required City permits.

PUT IT IN WRITING!

All requests and complaints should be put in writing and signed. Anonymous reports will not be addressed. Forms are available in the office for your convenience

Ancient human skulls hint at early European arrival

wo skulls unearthed in Greece suggest that Homo sapiens arrived in Europe from Africa much earlier than previously thought. The Sci-News website reports that the partial skulls were discovered decades ago, in 1978, but a recent re-examination allowed scientists to virtually reconstruct them.

One skull, 170,000 years old, belonged to a Neanderthal, but the other is 210,000 years old and appears to be an early modern human. This means that Homo sapiens spread out to Europe some 150,000 years earlier than believed. Scientists speculate that Neanderthals originally displaced Homo sapiens, but over time they died out as more early modern humans made their way to southern Europe.

Giant squid sighted off New Orleans coast

Tor the first time, a giant squid has been sighted and captured on video in U.S. waters, the *Popular Mechanics* website reports. A research vessel grabbed video of the squid, *Architeuthis dux*, 100 miles from the New Orleans coast. It's only the second footage of a giant squid in the wild; the first was captured on video in 2012 off Japan's Ogasawara archipelago.

The video was taken with a camera called Medusa, designed to resemble bioluminescent prey in the deep sea and attract predators like the giant squid to obtain a close-up look that can be recorded and studied.

Three myths about creativity

People have lots of misconceptions about the nature and practice of being creative. Here are some common myths to ignore (from the Livemint website):

• Creativity is serendipitous. Don't wait for the proverbial light bulb to go off inside your head. Enhance your imagination by talking to people, immersing yourself in information, and focusing on the problem you want to solve instead of hoping you'll get an idea out of the blue.

Although seeking input from others is useful—even essential—many great ideas come from people who weren't actively seeking solutions at the time. New material recharges devices as you walk

oon you may be able to recharge your smartphone by taking a walk, the Science Daily website reports. Scientists at the Chinese University of Hong Kong are developing an "energy harvester" that attaches to the knee, generating 1.6 microwatts of energy when the wearer walks at a normal pace, enough to power small devices like health monitors and GPS devices.

Scientists designed a special smart macrofiber material that generates energy from bending. The constant back-and-forth motion every time the knee flexes makes the device bend, creating electricity.

A prototype weighing just 0.68 pounds was tested on people walking at one to four miles per hour. Measurement of the wearers' breathing patterns with and without the device showed that it worked without any extra effort on the part of the walker. The device could enable users to stop worrying about the daily charge.

I believe it to be of particular importance that the scientist have an articulate and adequate social philosophy, even more important than the average man should have a philosophy.
