



## **SPRINKLERS:**

If there is a problem with the sprinklers, please let the office know so it can be repaired.

Do not adjust them. They are on timers and will come on and shut off automatically.

## **MAINTENANCE YARD:**

Everything in the yard is clearly marked for your convenience. If you take anything to the yard, please make sure you put the kitchen trash in dumpsters marked "Kitchen Trash Only". Do not put kitchen trash in the large roll offs located next to the entrance. Yard waste and other non-kitchen trash goes in the roll offs.

## **RECYCLING:**

Please do not put furnace filters, clothing, cushions and pillows in the recycling bin.

These items should be placed in one of the 2 large roll offs.

## **TRASH:**

All trash must be in bags and tied. No loose trash will be picked up.

Also, <u>trash and recycling must be out by 8:00am, but NOT overnight.</u> Place trash and recycling in a place where the maintenance crew can see it.

Do not mix yard waste with kitchen waste. Yard debris needs to be in bags or tied in bundles.

\*\*\*\*\*Please dispose adult diapers in a hygienical manner by placing in a plastic bag and tying it shut.\*\*\*\*

## BE CONSIDERATE OF YOUR RENTERS

It is the responsibility of the homeowners to make sure that any additional occupants in their home are properly registered with the park. If you are planning to rent out your home or have someone stay with you, review your Ranchero **Rules and Regulations** first. Additional occupants and renters must be registered with the office and a background check performed prior to their arrival. It is the Homeowners responsibility to meet all the requirements. The Office processes the applications as a courtesy for our homeowners but there is an application fee to cover the expense. Applications are available in the Office. They must be accompanied by two legible forms of identification for each person. For international applicants, copies of passports and driver's licenses are required. These should be submitted at least 30 days in advance of the person's arrival. Renters are to check in at the office upon arriving in the community.

IF YOU ARE A RENTER OR ADDITIONAL OCCUPANT and haven't done the above, please come to the office immediately and get properly registered. Thank You! <u>GUESTS</u>

#### Guests staying more than 1week MUST be registered in the Community Office.

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with

the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool.

## **SOLICITORS**

DO NOT, DO NOT LET STRANGERS INTO YOUR HOME. We can't possibly express it strongly enough. Residents are still being approached by door to door solicitors. DO NOT let them into your home! Call the Largo Police Department (587-6730) immediately if you see solicitors and please let the management office know after you have called the police. We have been trying to catch and trespass them. If we can even get a license plate number it would help immensely. Management has been working with the police in an attempt to stop these offenders. Ranchero is a plainly posted No Soliciting Community; no one should be coming to your door. These people are very bold and brazen; please help us stop them and any other solicitors before they take advantage of anyone else in our community. ONE WAY

As we look out the office window we see cars, trucks, bikes, motorized chairs and golf carts going in the WRONG direction. It makes us cringe! Please obey the ONE WAY signs and the big red sign that says: WRONG WAY. Cars are entering or backing out and don't always see the people going in the wrong direction behind them. We've seen so many close calls. Please go in the right direction and encourage others to do the same.

Also, bikers need to obey all the same signs as vehicles. Stop at the stop signs and look before proceeding...again, we've had some very close calls due to bikes not stopping or even checking to see if the way is clear. We don't want to see anyone hurt so please obey the rules of the road.

ENZYMES — There are preventative maintenance products that can be used in your home to help alleviate clogging of your sewer pipes. Both can be purchased at Home Depot. One is an enzyme that can be put down the kitchen sink to help with grease and the other is put in the outside clean out pipe or down the toilet to help with anything else that may be in the sewer lines. The plumbing department can help you find these products!

GLASS BOTTLES – It's time to enjoy the pool and the beautiful Florida sunshine. PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.

Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub. People have been seen eating on the side of the pool and having their drinks inside the pool and hot tub. Please do not do this.

**No smoking at the pools** – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas.

This includes vapor and e-cigarettes.

**Hot tubs** – these are for the use of <u>adults only</u>. No one under 18.



## Interstellar asteroid is a first

steroids can be found throughout our solar system, but astronomers have recently discovered one in interstellar space. The Science News website reports that the object, first believed to be a comet, is approaching the solar system at an unusually steep angle. Dubbed A/2017 U1, the asteroid is about 400 meters across and traveling 25.5 kilometers per second on a slingshot path past the sun. Astronomers plan to measure the colors in its reflected light to determine what it's made of and seek clues to its origins.

## Red sky in Asia mystery solved

It's a centuries-old mystery: In the year 1770, skies over Asia turned a bright red for nine days. The cause of this unusual phenomenon has never been identified. Now, though, scientists believe they have an answer.

As reported on the Slate website, researchers recently uncovered a collection of 111 contemporaneous documents from that time, and learned that the red sky had lasted longer than previously thought (just two days) and was much larger as well.

Scientists' conclusion: The effect was created by an aurora caused by solar activity, sparking the longest geomagnetic storm in recorded history.

A similar aurora was observed on two nights in 1859 by a massive solar storm known as the "Carrington Flare." Analysis of records of sunspot activity in 1770 suggests that the Asian aurora was caused by sunspot twice as large as those that created the Carrington event.

If such an event happened today, it would likely have catastrophic effects, knocking out satellites crucial to communications and GPS instruments.

## **New mineral found on Martian surface**

ASA has discovered evidence of an ironoxide mineral on the surface of Mars, the Sci-News website reports. The mineral, called hematite, was detected by spectral analysis of photos taken by the space agency's Curiosity rover in an area known as the Vera Rubin Ridge.

Curiosity zeroed in on a rock dubbed "Christmas Cove," and used its dust removal tool, a wire-bristled brushed, to uncover an area some 2.5 inches across.

Observations made the rover's Mast Camera (Mastcam) and its Chemistry and Camera (ChemCam) confirmed the presence of the hematite, a mineral that may provide information about ancient environmental conditions on the red planet.
