Bake It Easier

hese are special breakfast treats with a twist – soda instead of eggs – start the day off right.

Easy Scones – 10 mins. To make – Total time 30 Mins. – Makes 8.

- 3 cups Self-rising Flour
- ³/₄ cup Lemon-Lime soda (such as Sprite)
- ³/₄ cup Heavy Cream
 - 1. Heat oven to 400°, line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
- 2. Place the flour in a large bowl and make a well in the center of the flour. With a fork, gently stir in the soda and cream, mixing until incorporated (do not over mix).
- 3. Drop 8 large spoonfuls of dough on to the prepared baking sheet. Sprinkle with raw or granulated sugar, if desired, and bake until golden brown, 18 to 20 minutes. Serve warm with butter, honey or jam.

Per Scone: 268 cals. 86. fat (5 sat. fat) 31 mg. Chol. 631 mg. Sod. 66. pro. 439 CAL, 26 Fiber. Switch it up: For cheesy chive scones, add 1 cup shredded sharp cheddar and 2 tbsp. chopped chives to the flour.




