# In Memory of Elaine Lamora

y neighbor Elaine passed away November 18, 2015, she was 71 years old. She was always there to lend a helping hand. Being a retired nurse, she could even you free medical advice, which I always found very helpful.



Elaine moved to Florida in 1966 from Bow, New Hampshire and lived in Largo for a few years. Then in December 1969, was one of the first residents to Regency Heights.

When she moved here, she purchased a new home at Lot 119 for \$8,000., in addition, the lot rent was only \$35.00 a month. With the purchase, you also received plants for your flowerbed and sod for your lot. In addition, they put a sign in your lawn with your name on it. At first there were only sand roads and sand for your lot. However, the roads were paved, and lots sodded by March 1970. The Sales Office was located at Skylark Mobile Home Park, which use to be located where Kohl's is now. This was an adult park, no children and you had to be over 21 years old. Resident's ages ranged from 25 years to the oldest 100 years old.

Elaine said this land was purchased from Ed's Riding Stables by five investors. It was developed in three sections. The first year the first section ended at 8th Avenue, 2nd year it went to 9th Avenue and the 3rd year it was completed. Their first Friendship Dinner was held at the Skylark Club House with 36 people attending.

She remembered when SR 580 was just a two lane highway. In addition, there was only a caution light at US 19 and SR 580. The Countryside Mall was not built until 1974. You could buy your food at Publix on Sunset Point Road or in Dunedin. When the Club House caught on fire, the residents had to hose it down with their lawn hoses. The closest fire station was at Sunset Point Road.

By 1988, Elaine moved to Lot 420 because she purchased a dog. After 40 years working in Home Health she retired in 2006. In 2004, her father moved back to the park to be close to her. Every day you could see him riding thru the park and to the Steak n'Shake. Elaine was his caregiver until he passed away about 5 years ago.

You would always see Elaine sitting outside in her carport with many of her friends and neighbors visiting her for afternoon and evening chats. She is missed.

The Household Mobile Collection is FREE for Pinellas County residents. For more information on mobile collections or the permanent hazardous waste facility, contact Pinellas County Solid Waste at 727-464-7500 or visit <a href="https://www.pinellas.county.org/solidwaste">www.pinellas.county.org/solidwaste</a>. All events are on Saturdays from 9 am to 2 pm, collections may be delayed or canceled due to severe weather.

#### What to bring:

Electronics – Any device with a rechargeable battery, cell phones, computer towers/CPU's, drives (e.g. hard drives, CD drives), monitors smart phones, tablets and televisions.

Chemicals - Automotive fluids, batteries (household or vehicle), cleaners, cooking oil, fertilizers, fluorescent bulbs and other mercury containing devices, fuels (e.g. gasoline, kerosene), fungicides, herbicides, insecticides, motor oil, paint (latex or oil), paint remover, paint thinner, pesticides, pool chemicals, rechargeable batteries (button or vehicle), smoke detectors, solvents and wood preservatives.

#### What not to bring:

A/C units, alkaline batteries, appliances, biological/infectious waste, camcorders, CD players, copiers, digital cameras, DVD players, empty paint cans, explosives, fax machines, fire extinguishers, garbage, gas cylinders larger than one pound (e.g. propane tanks), GPS units, marine depth finders, medicine, microwave ovens, pagers, portable players (e.g.) MP3, iPOD), printers, printer/toner cartridges, radioactive waste, radios, stereo equipment, telephones, tires, VCRs and video game players.

The Collection Center close to us is at 29582 U.S. 19 N., behind the N. County Gov't. Center, south of Curlew Rd. The drop off day for this site is every fourth Saturday each month, 9 am to 2 pm. Any questions check the website or give them a call.

# The history of Black History Month

We owe much of our greater understanding of black history to Carter G. Woodson. Born to former slaves, Woodson worked hard and against the tide of prejudice to obtain his own education. In earning his doctorate from Harvard, Woodson was disturbed to find that during his studies, history books virtually ignored the black American population. So he decided to take on the challenge of writing black Americans into the history books.

He established the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History (now called the Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History) in 1915, and a year later founded the widely respected Journal of Negro History. Then in 1926, he launched Negro History Week, the precursor to Black History Month, as an initiative to bring national attention to the contributions of black people throughout American history.

February was chosen as Black History Month for the significant events and people who figured prominently in black American history. For example:

- Feb. 23, 1868: Civil rights leader and co-founder of the NAACP, W.E.B. DuBois, was born.
- Feb. 3, 1870: The 15th Amendment was passed, granting blacks the right to vote.
- Feb. 25, 1870: The first black U.S. senator, Hiram R. Revels (1822-1901), took his oath of office.
- Feb. 12, 1909: The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People was founded by a group of concerned black and white citizens in New York City.
- Feb. 1, 1960: A group of black Greensboro, North Carolina, college students began a sitin at a segregated Woolworth's lunch counter. The event marks a watershed moment in the civil-rights movement.


