

appy July 4th!!! Here we are getting ready to celebrate our country's freedom on July 4th already. It is a day of celebration for our independence from the British all those Lyears ago. What is going on around here this month you may be wondering. Well, not a whole heck of a lot. The manager, Susan Worden advises me that I will be allowed to hang a mail box in the clubhouse for the Monthly Media Information, as soon as the clubhouse remodeling is finished. They are painting it and doing some updating, and when that is done, she advises me that we will figure out a good place to hang the mailbox. That will get the box off the countertop and out of the way when functions are planned and yet give us a central permanent location for it. As usual, it is hot here, and of course as of the first of last month, hurricane season is here. It usually runs from June 1st through November 30th. This is the time of the year that I usually go over the importance of being ready and prepared for a storm should one come around into our lovely area. I have lived here for 8 years now and have yet to have to deal with a hurricane. However, I am always prepared, as I come from the Midwest area and we dealt with tornadoes in Indiana. Now those storms are hard to prepare for because they pop up quickly and can destroy miles of homes, buildings, etc. with very little, if any, warning that it is coming. The hurricanes are different in they build slowly and the weathermen can track them and keep us pretty well informed as to the path that they are "probably" going to take. Of course it is a science, and God will throw us a curve ball sometimes as to where they finally end up. My husband informs me that in our location here at the park, we are far enough away from the actual water, that a storm surge here would be very unlikely, but of course the winds and rains can create major destruction without us going under a surge of water. So it is imperative that you figure out an evacuation plan if that is ever ordered by the officials. As with both tornadoes and hurricanes, mobile homes are the first to be evacuated as they cannot withstand the high winds very well. So, what do you do if you are told to get out? Do you have animals that must evacuate with you? If so, you need to look for a shelter that you can take your animal with you. They will all require that the animal be up to date on its shots and vaccinations (you will have to have the paperwork to show) and you must have a pet cage/carrier to keep it in while in the shelter. Also you must consider if you have physical limitations, which shelter is best for you and handicapped accessible. These are the things that determine what and where your next step will be if you are told to evacuate and leave your home. The clubhouse is not an approved shelter, and cannot be used as such. The news stations and newspapers usually distribute a flyer advising where you can go, what you need to take with you and different ways of getting there if you do not drive. I know that several businesses have them at their stores for distribution to the public and they contain a wealth of information on what you need to do to be adequately prepared for the season. Personally,

I have two hurricane totes that I keep year round. They contain: a camp stove and bottled gas, llimitied cookware, a perk coffee pot, LED lanterns, a battery operated fan, a radio that is both battery and electric, a weather radio that is both electric and battery, flashlights, and a large supply of batteries. I check them every season to be sure I have adequate supplies of gas containers and batteries, and they are fresh and fully charged. Then if a storm is heading our way, and it appears we may need to "grab and go" I gather the other very important items that is needed to maintain us for 3-5 days, such as food, meds, bedding, important paperwork, insurance policies, etc. Water is also a much needed necessitiy so I make sure I have plenty to sustain us for several days. A generator is a wonderful item to have but we have not been able to get that yet, as they are expensive. My husband's folks lived in DeLand, Florida, and they had a hurricane hit their area in 2004. I learned a lot with what they had happen. They lived in a mobile home park off the St. John's river, and the storm did not directly hit them, but the winds were very strong and devastating. They were all told to evacuate, and the mobile home park had an approved shelter and the residents all went there. For several days the winds and rain beat at them. When the storm finally passed, they discovered their home suffered only minor damages. It was livable. But they had no electricity in the entire area. They had an LP gas stove and tank for cooking, and once it was inspected and determined to be okay, they at least were able to cook. However, the electricity was off for over a week. They were loaned a generator to run the freezers and refrigerator, and they survived until utililties were restored. I have an electric stove, so I purchased a gas camp stove to be able to cook and brew a pot of coffee. So I have tried to prepare us for a hurricane. I am thinking that if my home is destroyed, at least I will have the base necessities to be able to cook and take care of ourselves until things are sorted out. Survive and then rebuild if that is what God determines. So please give it some thought. Everyone needs to have a plan. If you have a neighbor, friends etc. that cannot drive or are physically limited, help them establish a plan of evacuation. Most of you probably are tired of my hurricane speach each year. But we have new residents that move in every year, many from northern areas and they are not aware of what all is involved in being ready for a hurricane. So if my words generate a mental note to check into being ready by one of our new neighbors, it is certainly worth my time to bring it up. So get prepared and stay safe this hurricane season. You need to keep a supply of your meds to get you through a few days, and you need to have your important papers organized so that you can grab them and go. If you have insurance, or not, it is imperative that you be able to prove to an adjustor or a FEMA person what you owned, so you need to take your phone and make a video of your entire home on the inside. Open the closets and drawers and cabinet doors and verbally say what is in there. Have the serial numbers of your TVs and computers and verbally say the make and model, size, etc and the serial number of your ty, appliances, etc. When you complete it, don't just keep it on your phone. Email it to your insurance agent for him/her to keep safe in his files. Download it to your computer. Put it on a flash drive/DVD or a backup system and keep it in a



safety deposit box. It is so much easier to prove what you had when your can show it exactly. This is necessary for any loss you may suffer. Fire or any kind of a loss. One of the TV stations mentioned to purchase a solar phone charger for your cell phone so that if we lose electricity you have a way of charging your phone and being reachable to family and friends who would be worrying about your well being. I dont have that yet, but am looking into getting one. So do your best to have a plan of action. You will be so much better off if you are prepared. And again, don't forget about your neighbors.

There has been much in the news lately about the water in cities and communities that we drink, cook with etc. This has come to light after the miserable failure in Flint, Michigan with their water system. So that has made most states and cities look at their water and determine if it is healthy etc. I can only speak for myself and my family, but we do not drink the tap water. The reason is it just doesn't taste good to us. So, here was my problem with buying water.....the expense and the plastic bottles that are so bad for the earth. My solution was to purchase a water cooler and two 5 gallon jugs. We go to Dunedin at the shopping center where McDonald's is and we get 5 gallons of reverse osmosis filtered water from the Windmill Express for a grand total of \$1.00 per 5 gallon container. Then we go through the drive up at McDonalds and buy ice from them. We get 8 pounds of ice for \$1.29 a bag. If you buy ice, I highly recommend getting it at the Dunedin McDonald's, as it is much cheaper than the gas/ grocery store ice. Not all McDonald's sell bagged ice, but the one in Dunedin and the one on 19N in Tarpon Springs does too. We don't litter the earth with all the plastic bottles and we have great tasting water for less than the cost of a 24 pack of cheap water. I only buy the bottled water for my hurricane boxes. Just thought I would share this information, because I don't think many people are aware they can purchase ice from some fast food restaurants. I also have bought ice at some Burger King's too. It is so much cheaper than anywhere else. We bring it home and put it in the ice bin of the refrigerator and make sure the ice maker is turned off. It works out well. Check it out.

The fires still blaze in Canada, although I am praying that by now it is under some form of control, and we pray for our Canadian extended family that all are safe and sound and far from danger. Remember to pay it forward by helping out someone today. You never know when you will need help some day. Life is too short to not care about your fellow person who is struggling. #### Gardening Tips.

n gardening some techniques work, some don't, and all require physical effort. The good part is that even if your garden doesn't do well the exercise you get is a health plus. You can grow flowers, vegetables, and various ornamental plants, and even cactus here. So... vegetables first.

Peppers, beans, cucumbers, and tomatoes seem to be the most popular vegetables to grow not only here but in the north as well. The challenge is that the heat during the summer here is really rough on the plants (and us) so think about where there might be some shade for your plants part of the day. In addition to that the soil conditions (especially in this area) leave much to be desired but there are some solutions for that. Much of what follows applies to flowers as well as vegetables and shrubs.

Some folks add potting soil to the area they are going to plant which is a good idea if you add enough and go deep enough. Most references say that you must go at least 6 inches deep, 10 to 12 inches is preferable. That means digging the ground (work) and removing the existing dirt and then buying enough potting soil to fill the area you dug out. That can be expensive. Other options are adding nutrients and trace minerals to the existing soil... more digging (more work) and a considerable amount of research.

Things like "Grow Boxes" cut down on the amount of "soil work" in the sense that you don't have to dig if you are using that method. I used them last year but I didn't plant an actual garden this year even though I have the grow boxes. A grow box is a system wherein the soil is placed in a container that has a reservoir for water in the base on the device. There are several companies that make those and design plus price varies. You fill the upper part with potting soil, wet it thoroughly, plant your plants, and fill the reservoir with water. Then all you have to do is fill the reservoir occasionally. I use the brand called "Garden Patch Grow Boxes" at http:// www.agardenpatch.com. Even if you don't use their boxes they have a lot of good information on their website. I did discover that during the hottest months here I had to fill the reservoir every other day but that would apply to any brand. If you are handy there are plenty of "How To" videos on YouTube about making your own boxes.

Flowers can be grown in "boxes" as well but many of us plant them in the ground or pots. Either way they will need to be fertilized from time to time. And most fertilizers don't contain the other minerals that plants need to be really healthy so many gardeners add to the soil (even potting soil). Rock dust or glacial rock dust is the most common. I add one handful at the bottom of each container before putting the soil in or mix a hand full with the soil beforehand. There are many sources for glacial dust, I use a brand called Azomite. It comes in small

quantities as well as truck loads. A 5-pound bag will be enough for almost any small garden.

Pest control – a necessary evil that if you don't do it your plants (especially vegetables) will fall prey to them. Sevin dust and a spray bottle with a couple tablespoons of Dawn dishwashing liquid and the rest water is all you will need in most cases. Companion planting also helps (vampires aren't the only pests the don't like garlic) so do some research on that.

I planted Zinnias (seeds) and a couple of pepper plants this year because I am really lazy.

Gardening, I think, is one of the most enjoyable, and healthy activities one can do. It not only is good exercise but it challenges the brain as well... you know, that muscle seldom used by Politicians. Do your research, think about what and where you want to plant, and then get your hands dirty.

Now, in parting I am going to pass on a tip I learned at Koffee Klatch. It was only 5 words, straight and to the point. The perfect tip for really lazy gardeners so naturally I had to try it. The words? White rocks and plastic plants. Yup... works great.

One additional comment. I am not affiliated with any of the products I mention and receive no gratuities from them.

#### POOL AND PET OWNER REMINDERS

**FYI:** Riviera Estates MHP would like to remind our residents that **NO one is allowed to touch the temperature settings on the pool heater and/or the clubhouse air conditioner.** Our manager and the Homeowner's Association Executive Board have insisted on this. Pool hours are 9:00 a.m. until dusk daily. Pool is heated in winter, the months of November through March.

ATTENTION PET OWNERS: Please be a responsible pet owner and a **RESPECTIBLE** pet owner as well. When walking your pets, please do not allow them to "potty" in other people's yards. Some are not pet lovers as we are. Your dogs must be leashed at all times, and there are plenty of areas where your dog can go. There is a pet cleanup station in the storage field for your use. Please be sure to **clean up** after your pet. Also, please try to keep your pet from barking or making loud disturbing noise that can bother a neighbor. Complaints are being received by the office on a constant basis of pet problems in the park. So, at this time, our pet rule policy should be noted. Pets are allowed in park, UP TO 20 POUNDS weight restriction. Copies of pet innoculation certificate must be givien to the office as proof the pet has been vaccinated. There is a LIMIT OF TWO PETS PER COACH. Fences for the pets are not allowed to be installed. All pets must be leased at all times when outside the coach. Make certain when you leave your pet, they are not barking the entire time vou are gone and bothering your neighbors. If this is the case, please make some type of arrangements that will alter this situation, such as a pet sitter, taking pet with you, or if the problem continues, and complaints continue in the office from residents being bothered by the barking, the park is forced to take steps in resolving the issue, such as requiring you to get rid of the dog, or face eviction procedures. Please be a responsible pet owner and obey the rules concerning them It is IMPERATIVE THAT YOU CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET EVERYWHERE, INCLUDING THE DOG WALKING AREA. Please do not ignore these pet owner rules, so that we all can continue to love and enjoy our pets. But at all times we must be respectful of all the residents that live here, that they are not bothered by our pets in any way. 


