

### FROM THE CO-EDITOR

Tello everyone, it is June and guess what time of year that is? It is Hurricane season! On Mother's Day last month the hurricane guide was in the Sunday newspaper...if you Ledon't get the newspaper, you can usually pick one up at the various local stores. Time to be prepared. If a storm is headed our way, the residents of mobile homes are the first to be evacuated. So if that time comes (like last year's Irma) you must make certain you and your pets are taken care of. Stock up non-perishable foods for you and pets, water for both, medications and important paperwork. Put the paperwork, like titles to home, vehicles, insurance policies, pet papers on shots etc. in one place to grap and go. Make sure you have a car charger for your phone, in case we lose power. Check the shelters of where you need to go and if they are pet friendly. To take a pet to a shelter they must be in crates/carriers and have their CURRENT shot records. I have 3 large hurricane boxes. One contains the food from my cabinets and fridge and freezers. I have a second one with pots/pans cooking utensils, a gas camp stove and containers of gas and an old perk coffee pot. This way I can cook and not lose all my food. If you are in a position to purchase a generator, now is the time to do it. Don't wait till the storm is upon us and start trying to find one. When Irma hit last year, there was no generators to be found! I was raised as a girl scout to always be prepared. Also in another box I have batteries, battery operated radio, lanterns and a fan to circulate some air. Get as prepared as you can be to survive a week or more if there is no power. You won't regret being prepared. Last year, after Irma was determined to be headed our way, the mandatory evacuation was issued and the park management had a school bus come in at take residents to shelters. If you have a pet, you have to be sure the shelter will take it. Many got hotel/motel rooms and others went to be with friends/family in a conventional built building. The club house is NOT an approved shelter and is locked. They are predicting an active year so do not shrug off the warnings. We were lucky Irma did very little damage here in our park and I am praying we don't have to evacuate again this year. Be safe everyone.



I regret to inform that one of our matriarchs of the park, Dot Haggerty passed away around the end of May. Sadly, Dot lost her fight with cancer, after battling it for a long time. She was a sweet lady who enjoyed everyone. For many years she managed the park and ran the office. Dot and I enjoyed doing our walking and water exercising in the pool. I spoke to her right before she passed and she was determined to continue fighting, which encouraged me. Her buddy Denise Childs passed on March 31st and they went to chemo treatments together and laughed a lot and made a bad day turn into a good one. Rest in heaven Dot, we certainly do miss you tremendously already.

So what is happening in this month of June? Well June 14th is Flag Day, and also my birthday!!! The 17th is Father's Day, so be sure to honor thy father, here or in Heaven as he was influencial for you being who you are today.

As ever, please pay it forward as often as you can. On that note, a huge big "Thank You!" to Alberta McClure for her donation of two large boxes full of hygenic items for the homeless. Very much appreciated. Please continue to pray for the residents in the park who are battling illnesses. Stay healthy and have a great month!



### **ACTIVITIES AND REMINDERS:**

**Pool:** the rules are posted at the pool, however, a review is needed to keep the pool safe and fun for all. Please do not touch the "heater" settings, this is controlled by management. No glass bottles/drinking glasses, etc. **When you leave, please be courteous and roll the umbrellas down so they will not be damaged if a wind/storm comes up.** If you see them up, and no one is in the pool, please put them down. They are expensive to continually replace. No pets are allowed in the pool area. Be sure to rinse off before getting into the pool to keep from allowing oil/lotion etc. Into the pool water. Do not allow grand children to swim unattended. Jumping and splashing is not received well by many swimmers. Review the rules and make sure you are abiding by them.

Clubhouse: the clubhouse is not a storm shelter of any kind. Also, grandchildren should not be in the clubhouse unattended. There is a free library, please return books when you are finished with them. Unfortuately, the cabinets, refrigerator etc. Are locked as we kept having things mysteriously disappear. If you need to have them unlocked for use of a private party. See an officer of the good neighbors for list of who have keys. Be sure to lock all up when you leave. The clubhouse can be used for private parties. There is a calendar posted on the board and if you need to use the clubhouse for a family/private gathering, list it on the date with your name and time needed. We have many wonderful parties in the clubhouse and the bulletin boards is where you learn what is coming up and sign up if you are interested. Be sure when you leave, if the clubhouse is empty, turn off the lights etc. Make certain stove/oven are turned off.

**Speed:** the speed in the park is to be 15 mph. Even though this is a senior park, there are guests and grandchildren visiting. They like to play outside, ride bikes, etc. A speeding vehicle is an accident waiting to happen. Please also tell your guests/family to respect the speed limit. Don't be surprised if you are yelled at by a resident to slow down if you are going too fast. Signs are posted so please be aware of your speed.

**Pets:** this is a pet friendly park with certain rules. It is required that you be a responsible pet owner. Cats are considered to be "inside" pets and are not to be running free all over the park. If you have a dog, please pick up after them. There is a pet disposal station in the rv lot. Do not allow your dog to use yards to do their business in. Some homeowners are not pet lovers and do not want them in their yards doing their business. Please use your own yard or the rv lot. It is important that we are respectful so we can continue to enjoy our dogs and not cause any anxiety with non-pet residents.





### **Ancient humans cared for others**

Popular culture paints our Neanderthal ancestors as brutish and cruel, but that picture is changing, according to the Sci-News website.


Neanderthals are known to have cared for their injured people, and new findings suggest that they took care of individuals who were suffering regardless of whether their peers could repay them in any way.

For example, the remains of one male Neanderthal 25-40 years old at time of death shows that he had a variety of diseases, including tooth loss, periodontal disease, arthritis, and other long-term health conditions. His care would have required fever management, hygiene maintenance, and helping him stay with the group when it moved its camp. For the last 12 months of his life he would have been unable to contribute much to the group, but he was carefully buried after his death.

The evidence suggests that "organized, knowledgeable, and caring health care is not unique to our species but rather has a long evolutionary history," one scientist states.

### A once-in-a billion-year spin

alaxies rotate, just as Earth and other planets do. However, their spin is remarkably consistent, regardless of size. The Discover Magazine website reports that scientists have determine that all galaxies rotate approximately once every billion years, whether they're massive spiral galaxies or small irregular dwarfs.



Researchers measured the velocities of hydrogen in the outer discs of a variety of galaxies differing in size. The measurements allowed them to calculate the rotation period of each galaxy. "Discovering such regularity in galaxies really helps us to better understand the mechanics that make them tick," one scientist says.

### **Exercise boosts immunity in older adults**

xercise is good at any age, but scientists now think that regular exercise as you get older may help boost your immune system and prevent infections.

An article on the BBC website reports that scientists in the United Kingdom tracked 125 long-distance cyclists, some in their 80s, and discovered they had immune systems comparable to those of 20-year-olds.

The researchers examined the cyclists' blood for T-cells, which aid the immune system in fighting off infections. The long-distance riders had the same level of T-cells as adults in their 20s, but a similar group of older adults who were less active produced fewer T-cells.`

The research suggests that increased physical activity can also help older people respond better to vaccines for such infections as the flu.

### These foods keep your brain healthy

ome foods help keep your heart in shape. Others help your bones. What keeps your brain and memory healthy? The CNN website offers this list of what to eat to maintain a healthy brain as you grow older:

- Berries. Studies suggest that eating at least a half-cup of blueberries, or one cup of strawberries, on a weekly basis may help stave off cognitive decline. Berries have anthocyanidins, whose antioxidant and anti-inflammatory effects may keep the brain in shape.
- Green leafy vegetables. One study of almost 1,000 adults found that a daily serving of spinach, kale, collard greens, or arugula appeared to maintain cognitive health to the extent that participants were considered to be 11 years younger than people who rarely or never consume such veggies.
  - Eggs. Eggs contain choline, which is an important brain nutrient. In a study of 1,400 people, participants with high intakes of choline scored better of visual and verbal memory tests than those who ate less foods with choline. In addition,
    - people with a high intake of choline over the long term seem to have better MRI brain scans, suggesting that choline may protect people against dementia.
