He was such a wealth of information. I remember him telling us about the World War and Depression. He was unable to serve, so he was here while the majority of our men were off fighting in the war. He was a meat cutter by trade and he told me about how they had to ration the food items, etc. During the war, it was not unusual for families to move in together and live under one roof to survive and that is what my father's family did. They pooled their ration cards together to be able to get through the month. So many stories he told us. His pet peeve was how badly people today waste things. He taught me never to let anything go to waste. Freeze it, can it, dehydrate it, whatever you needed to do to preserve it and use it up. To this day, I continue to do that. Being in the grocery/food business, he unknowingly was involved in the making of the atomic bomb. My uncle was the CEO of a steel mill and called my father inquiring if he could connect him with train cars full of barley. Said it was top secret, he could not tell him why he needed so much barley, but my father got him connected with the proper mills, etc. and had no idea that it was needed as part of that bomb making process. He was pretty shocked when he was told he aided his country in the making of the bomb. Since he was unable to serve due to health reasons, he was able to be of service in that way. My father was also a beautiful gardener, his yard and flowers were always breathtakingly beautiful. I certainly did not inherit his green thumb. He would not be pleased with my flowers and landscaping. If you are lucky

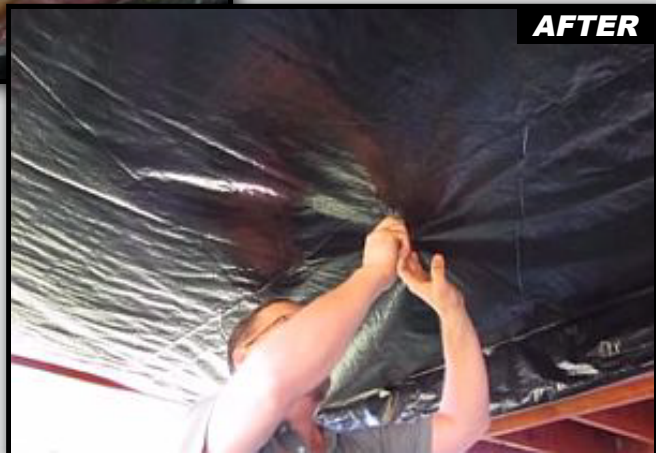

Free and Inexpensive things to do in the Clearwater area.

Beach Walk: A couple of our Good Neighbors Club members take this scenic walk 2 or 3 times a week and that got me to thinking about things to do around the area that do not cost an arm and a leg and in many cases free. So I did a little research and came up with some interesting things to do that you might not thought of.

Clearwater, Florida's Beach Walk is a popular waterfront strip open to pedestrians, cyclists and in-line skaters. The area is close to Clearwater's commercial district, but also has a quiet, tranquil atmosphere and incredible views of the ocean and coastline. From Riviera Estates go North to Curlew and turn left. Just follow Curlew as it turns into Causeway Blvd at Alt 19. Stay on Causeway Blvd, cross over the Causeway Blvd Draw bridge, and then you are able to park anywhere along the left side. If you get to Royal Stewart Arms Condos on the right, you went too far. There are benches for you to sit and watch the sunset if you don't feel like a stroll down the walk.

Jolley Trolley: For a fun ride that costs next to nothing jump on the Jolley Trolley. The Jolley Trolley shares most of the designated stops with the PSTA, just look for our sign posted at their stops. 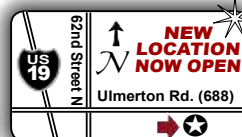

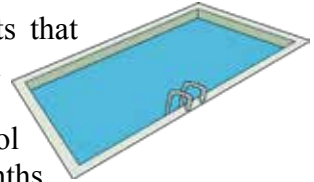

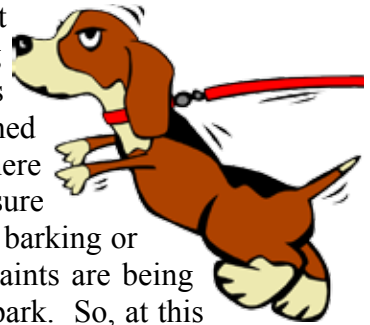
ACTIVITIES AND REMINDERS

POOL AND PET OWNER REMINDERS

FYI: Riviera Estates MHP would like to remind our residents that **NO one is allowed to touch the temperature settings on the pool heater and/or the clubhouse air conditioner.** Our manager and the Homeowner's Association Executive Board have insisted on this. Pool hours are 9:00 a.m. until dusk daily. Pool is heated in winter, the months of November through March.



ATTENTION PET OWNERS: Please be a responsible pet owner and a **RESPECTIBLE** pet owner as well. When walking your pets, please do not allow them to "potty" in other people's yards. Some are not pet lovers as we are. Your dogs must be leashed at all times, and there are plenty of areas where your dog can go. There is a pet cleanup station in the storage field for your use. Please be sure to **clean up** after your pet. Also, please try to keep your pet from barking or making loud disturbing noise that can bother a neighbor. Complaints are being received by the office on a constant basis of pet problems in the park. So, at this time, our pet rule policy should be noted. Pets are allowed in park, **UP TO 20 POUNDS** weight restriction. Copies of pet inoculation certificate must be given to the office as proof the pet has been vaccinated. There is a **LIMIT OF TWO PETS PER COACH.** Fences for the pets are not allowed to be installed. All pets must be leashed at all times when outside the coach. Make certain when you leave your pet, they are not barking the entire time you are gone and bothering your neighbors. If this is the case, please make some type of arrangements that will alter this situation, such as a pet sitter, taking pet with you, or if the problem continues, and complaints continue in the office from residents being bothered by the barking, the park is forced to take steps in resolving the issue, such as requiring you to get rid of the dog, or face eviction procedures. Please be a responsible pet owner and obey the rules concerning them. It is **IMPERATIVE THAT YOU CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET EVERYWHERE, INCLUDING THE DOG WALKING AREA.** Please do not ignore these pet owner rules, so that we all can continue to love and enjoy our pets. But at all times we must be respectful of all the residents that live here, that they are not bothered by our pets in any way. Not by hearing them all the time, or stepping in their waste when out walking etc. Thank you for adherence to the policies and rules.

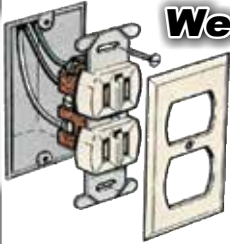

Coffee may keep you healthy

Is drinking coffee good for you? A recent article on The New York Times website linked to a number of different studies touting the positive effects of caffeine on several different health problems. They include:

- Liver damage. A review of data collected by studies of more than 430,000 people found that coffee may lower the risk of cirrhosis of the liver, a disease associated with overindulgence in alcohol (among other causes).
- Tinnitus. Researchers kept track of more than 65,000 women and found that those who drank more than one 8-ounce cup of coffee a day were less likely to suffer from tinnitus, that persistent ringing or buzzing in your ears.
- Auto crashes. A study of truck drivers who routinely work on long hauls found that coffee drinkers (or consumers of other caffeinated drinks) seem 63 percent less likely to be involved in crashes while driving.
- Melanoma. An analysis of health and dietary data involving more than 400,000 people ages 50-71 found that those who drank four or more cups of coffee a day were 20 percent less likely to develop skin cancer. (The researchers cautioned that avoiding exposure to the sun's ultraviolet rays is still the most important way to avoid melanoma.)

Americans tend to be an impatient bunch. A study by fulfillment software vendor Temando found that 80 percent of U.S. consumers want same-day shipping from retailers, and 61 percent want their purchases shipped out even faster, within three hours.

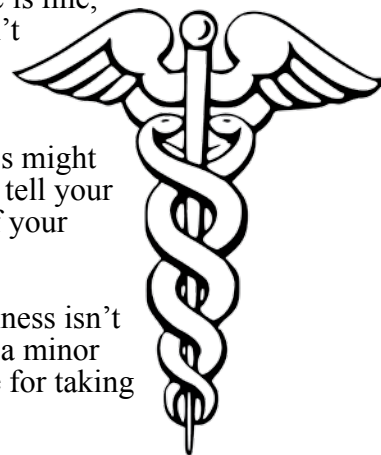


Retailers haven't responded, at least not yet. The study noted that only 53 percent offer same-day shipping even though 55 percent of buyers indicated they'd be willing to pay for it, and only 20 percent send products within three hours, although 31 percent said they'd be ready to pay for that.

Watch your words when talking to doctors

Communicating with your doctor is important, but you can overdo it. From the Prevention.com website comes this lists of things doctors don't want to hear from their patients:

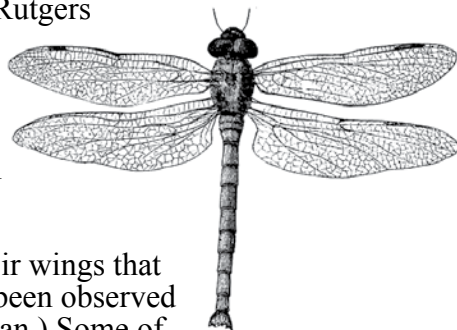
- "I'm sure I have ____." Researching your symptoms online is fine, but most doctors want to diagnose illnesses themselves. Don't walk into the doctor's office insisting you know what's wrong.
- "It's probably just stress." Writing off your problems to stress might keep you from fully describing what's going on. Be ready to tell your doctor all your symptoms so he or she can get a clear idea of your illness.
- "I'm sorry for wasting your time." You may feel that your illness isn't important, but doctors would prefer that you come in before a minor ailment turns into a serious one. You don't have to apologize for taking care of your health.
- "Haven't you heard of this new drug?" Doctors are busy people who don't have time to keep up with every new medication, no matter how hard they try. Don't insist that your doctor prescribe something you saw on TV, but do print out articles that might be helpful in treating your illness.
- "You're supposed to be the expert." Again, doctors are human, and they sometimes miss things. Have realistic expectations, and talk openly about your needs so the doctor can make an informed decision.





Dragonfly breaks record for longest flight

Birds may fly great distances, but the world's leading long-distance flyer is a dragonfly an inch and a half long, according to biologists at Rutgers University-Newark. A species of dragonfly known as *Pantala flavescens* can be found in areas as far apart as eastern Canada, Texas, Japan, and India. Their work found that dragonflies in all these locations share a common gene pool, showing that they were able to travel vast distances to intermingle with local species.



The dragonflies have an increased surface area on their wings that lets wind carry them across oceans. (Some have already been observed migrating between Asia and Africa across the Indian Ocean.) Some of them may actually make the long journey without stopping, stroking the air and then gliding for extended periods to conserve their energy.

Monarch butterflies were previously thought to migrate the farthest distance of any creature—2,500 miles—but if the Rutgers biologists are correct, the dragonflies have set a new record.

Microwaves make rubies sparkle

Want to make your jewelry sparkle? Try putting it in the microwave. Actually, that may not be your best or safest bet, but scientists have discovered that a microwave treatment can improve the clarity and color of rubies, which aside from jewelry are used in high-power switches and sensors.



As reported on the Science Daily website, a research team at India's Institute of Minerals and Materials Technology (IMMT) put a series of natural, hexagonal rubies in a standard 3MW microwave furnace and heated them at 1,500 degrees Celsius. The microwaves changed the gemstones' color and structure, turning them from reddish black to bright pink and smoothing out defects and impurities by altering their atomic layout and crystal structure.

The process is promising because it's quicker than regular heating and ensures uniformity, and is also more energy efficient.

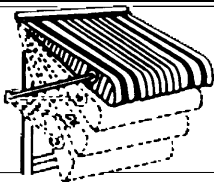

Did Neanderthals build their own fires?

Our Neanderthal ancestors may have used chemistry to start fires, according to an article on the Scientific American website. Archeologists have found chunks of black manganese oxides in Neanderthal sites for years. Previously they believed the oxides were used for dark body paint, although other sources like ash and charcoal would have been more easily available to them.



Scientists at Leiden University in the Netherlands, though, analyzed some chunks of manganese found at a site in southern France and discovered that the blocks contained manganese dioxide, which is more flammable than other types of manganese. Groundup particles of the substances can lower the ignition temperature of wood by more than 100 degrees—suggesting that instead of relying on naturally occurring fires sparked by lightning, Neanderthals were able to build fires on their own.

Radio bursts detected from neutron star

They're not signals from an advanced alien civilization, but they've been a mystery to astronomers for years. Fast radio bursts, or FRBs, are bursts of energy from outer space lasting just milliseconds but emitting as much energy as the sun produces in 10,000 years. Only 17 have ever been recorded, all of them apparently one-time events.



But a repeating FRB has recently been detected, according to the Sci-News website: Astronomers from McGill University using the Arecibo radio telescope in Puerto Rico have recorded a series of 10 FRBs they believe may emanate from a rotating neutron star in a distant galaxy.

This conflicts with previous theories that FRBs are caused by cataclysmic events such as supernovas or the creation of black holes. Whatever their origin, the truth is out there.

The Internet spreads across the globe

Access to the Internet has expanded around the world, according to the Pew Research Center. A global survey found that 54 percent of people in the developing world consider themselves “Internet users” in 2015, up from 45 percent just two years earlier. Those users include 37 percent of survey respondents who said they own a smartphone, an increase from 21 percent in 2013.



Still, growth is slow in some parts of the world. In Africa, the countries Burkina Faso, Uganda, and Ethiopia have Internet use rates below 20 percent. The rate is 42 percent in South Africa and 39 percent of Nigeria, two of Africa’s largest economies.

Meanwhile, advanced economies have much higher rates—94 percent in South Korea, 93 percent in Australia, 90 percent in Canada, 89 percent in the United States, and 89 percent in the United Kingdom.

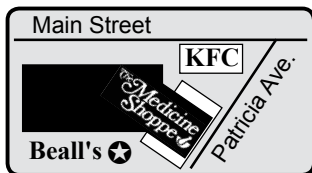
