We have been busy trying to get things caught up around here after my health issues with my hip and it is really not an easy task to try to clean after a year of just a lick and a promise, but I am determined to take it room by room and get at least half done in a day. We also need to get the north outside wall powerwashed, and then things will be a bit better.

I am looking forward to going to the pool and exercising, I keep saying that, but haven't made it yet. It has to be really warm, I cannot get chilled as my joints scream at me if I do, so waiting for the hot days so I can go everyday. I am feeling better just thinking about it LOL. I do water aerobics and swim and when the pool is real busy during the winter months when heated I feel like I am "taking over" the pool. I like to go around 5 in the evening when most are preparing and eating supper, so it is not busy.

It is with great sadness that I report we lost Denise Childs on March 31st, after a very courageous battle with cancer. She will be sorely missed. She loved this park, and said it was the best thing she had done when she moved here. She loved and enjoyed her "Galli" (her dog,) even when he gave her a hard time. He brought her a lot of joy. She was described as "a peach" of a girl by Dot Haggerty, who said she and Denise went to their treatments together, and they laughed and had such a good time while doing so. She brought joy and had a wonderful smile. I will miss her and know she is now no longer suffering while being in God's glory. Rest in Peace Denise, you certainly deserve it.

So what is going on in May? Well according to my handy dandy calendar a LOT! May 1st

is May day, also International Workers Day. May 3rd is National Day of Prayer, May 5th is Cinco de Mayo. May 6th starts National Pet Week. May 13th is Mother's Day. Ramadon begins on May 15th at sundown.May 19th is Armed Forces Day. May 21st is Victoria Day for Canada and also National Patriot's Day. May 26th is National Sorry Day for Austrailia. And the 28th of May is Memorial Day. So alot to celebrate this month. I am from Indiana, and May is all about the Indianpolis 500 race with track testing, qualifying, tire testing, etc. and of course the big race on the Sunday of Memorial Weekend.

So how are you planning on spending your summer? I am going to get back on my diet (I better) as I am going the wrong way since my hip surgery. I use the Weight Watcher program Smart Points and it has been very difficult for me to get back on it. My appetite seems unquenchable, which was never a problem when I was in that pain with my hip. I had no appetite. Made losing weight much easier than it is now.....so I have to be even more vigilent. Got to get it going the other way.....so there is this new recipe I have been using a lot. We love pizza here at the Walls household, and I could not find a pizza dough recipe I liked that wasn't sooooo many points until now.. This dough is used for pizza dough, bagels, pretzels, garlic knots, breadsticks, etc. Bread is pretty much a no no on any diet, but is allowed on WW, you just lose so many of your points for the good tasting ones. So this has become my go to dough recipe. You take 1 cup of nonfat plain yogurt, mix in 1-1/2 cups of self rising flour. It is pretty sticky, but mix it well and cover and let rest for 15-20 min. Flour your surface, roll the dough out onto the floured area, sprinkle flour on top, knead, adding enough flour till it becomes a smooth dough. Let rest again. Meanwhile, spray your pizza pan with Pam (I use olive oil spray) and place the dough on it. Spray a sheet of plastic wrap or waxed paper, lay it on top of the dough, and spread it to fit the pan with your hands. Bake until it begins to brown, at 400 degrees, then take it out, let cool, add toppings and bake till bubbly. I use lots of vegetables, cheese (reduced fat) etc. The only points are for the crust and it works out to be very low so you can have 2 or 3 slices and still be within your point range for the meal. For bagels, you cut the dough into 4 sections, roll each into a rope and then make a bagel shape, brush with egg bath, sprinkle spices and salt (whatever you like) or cinnamon, bake till golden. They are very good and low in points. Same with pretzels (only make the rope longer and twist into pretzel shape). I love the garlic knots which you tie a rope of dough into a knot, brush liberally with oil and garlic, bake till golden brown. Try it. My family likes it very much.

Another recipe I want to share is Easy Grilled Steak: 1 1/2 teasp fresh chopped basil, 1 1/2 teasp fresh chopped parsley. 2 teasp minced garlic. 1/2 teasp salt, 1/4 teasp pepper. 1 pound lean steak. Mix the spices together, coat top and bottom of steak. Grill 4 min on each side or until desired tenderness. This is quick and easy and serves 4, each serving is 3 WW Freestyle Smart Points.

One of my quick go to lunches is tuna salad in a crisp lettuce leaf bowl. Tuna, celery, onions, dill pickle relish and Olive Oil Kraft Mayo, mix together. Wash and dry lettuce leaf (can use cabbage, greens, any thing you like) place tuna in it and fold and eat like a sandwich.

I use egg salad, tacos etc. like this too. Or if you want a crispy taco shell, take 1/4 cup low fat cheese and place in hot skillet. It will bubble up and cook very quickly and as it starts to brown, lift it out of pan and allow it to bend and form like a taco shell, then let it cool. Stuff with meat, lettuce, tomato, onion, FF sour cream etc. Crunchy and delish.

What about that sweet tooth you ask? I take an angel food cake mix that calls for water only, dump dry mix in a large bowl, add a 20 oz can of crushed pineapple in its own juice, juice and all, mix well. It will foam up like crazy. Place in angel food cake pan, bake per directions. This is a very moist cake, super easy, sweet, and is only 2 points for 1/12th slice. Or take a spice cake mix, add a 15 oz can of pumpkin puree, 1/2 cup water, 1/2 cup walnuts. Bake per package directions and you have a yummy pumpkin bar only 2 points for 1/12th. You can get creative and add raisins, cinnamon chips, choc chips etc. but the chips add points to it. I stick with the nuts and raisins. It is so good, satisfies my sweet tooth and keeps me in line. Try some of these, you will be surprised.

Hurricane season is right around the corner, starts June 1st and they are predicting several storms with a couple of them becoming major. Next month I will give my "Hurricane Preparedness" speech to you. I am sure you just can't wait LOL. I do it so that new residents who may be spending their first hurricane season in Florida will know what they need to do. Sorry if I bore you but better to be safe than sorry.

In closing, I want to ask that you continue to pay it forward. Check on your neighbors, make sure they are doing all right, share a case of water with those less fortunate, buy a breakfast for that struggling person, etc. Do what you can to make your day and someone else's a great day. Also I ask that continued prayers be said for those residents who are struggling with health issues.

### **ACTIVITIES AND REMINDERS:**

**POOL:** The rules are posted at the pool, however, a review is needed to keep the pool safe and fun for all. Please do not touch the "heater" settings, this is controlled

by management. No glass bottles/drinking glasses, etc. When you leave, please be courteous and roll the umbrellas down so they will not be damaged if a wind/storm comes up. If you see them up, and no one is in the pool, please put them down. They are expensive to continually replace. No pets are allowed in the pool area. Be sure to

rinse off before getting into the pool to keep from allowing oil/lotion etc. Into the pool water. Do not allow grand children to swim unattended. Jumping and splashing is not received well by many swimmers. Review the rules and make sure you are abiding by them.

**CLUBHOUSE:** The clubhouse is not a storm shelter of any kind. Also, grandchildren should not be in the clubhouse unattended. There is a free library, please return books when you are finished with them. Unfortunately, the cabinets, refrigerator etc. Are locked as we kept having things mysteriously disappear. If you need to have them unlocked for use of a private party. See an officer of the good neighbors for list of who have keys. Be sure to lock all up when you leave. The clubhouse can be used for private parties. There is a calendar posted on the board and if you need to use the clubhouse for a family/private gathering, list it on the date with your name and time needed. We have many wonderful parties in the clubhouse and the bulletin boards is where you learn what is coming up and sign up if you are interested. Be sure when you leave, if the clubhouse is empty, turn off the lights etc. Make certain stove/oven are turned off.

**SPEED:** The speed in the park is to be 15 mph. Even though this is a senior park, there are guests and grandchildren visiting. They like to play outside, ride bikes, etc. A speeding vehicle is an accident waiting to happen. Please also tell your guests/family to respect the speed limit. Don't be surprised if you are yelled at by a resident to slow down if you are going too fast. Signs are posted so please be aware of your speed.



PETS: This is a pet friendly park with certain rules. It is required that you be a responsible pet owner. Cats are considered to be "inside" pets and are not to be running free all over the park. If you have a dog, please pick up after them. There is a pet disposal station in the rv lot. Do not allow your dog to use yards to do their business in. Some homeowners are not pet lovers and do not want them in their yards doing their business. Please use your own yard or the rv lot. It is important that we are respectful so we can continue to enjoy our dogs and not cause any anxiety with non-pet residents.

• A lower death rate.



Coffee's natural antioxidants reduce free radicals that can damage cells and cause aging. It's also an anti-inflammatory that calms you down so you don't overact to stress.

One group that should avoid coffee, however, is pregnant women. Coffee, the study notes, can increase the risk of miscarriage.

### Be ready to donate

re you nervous about donating blood or signing up to be an organ donor? You don't have to be. An infographic from Work The World explores some of the common misconceptions about blood and organ donations. They include:

• Age. There is no age limit on organ donations. In fact, the oldest known donor to date was a Scottish woman of 107 who donated one of her corneas after death. The main factor is the health of the organ and the donor.

• Organs. A single organ donor can improve or save up to eight lives. Donating tissue can save even more.

• Blood type. All blood types are needed, even the most common ones.

• Tattoos. Got a tattoo? That won't prevent you from donating blood as long as you're otherwise healthy.
