FROM THE EDITOR'S DESK

ay is here with all that comes with it, here in Florida it means the return of heat and humidity and lazy summer days. The northerners mostly have deserted us, but I wonder who all will be returning to snow/ice? It has been quite a severe winter up north this year. Be safe my friends.

Sadly, we lost another resident this month here at Riviera......Bob Dunlap left us to go be embraced in heaven. Please remember Cathy and his family in your thoughts and prayers and let them know you are there for them in their time of grief.

So what is happening in May you ask? Well, of course the first is May Day. The 5th is Cinco de Mayo and National Teachers Day. The 6th is Wishbone Day, and of course, the 10th is Mother's Day. The 16th is Armed Forces Day for the USA.

The 18th is Victoria Day for Canada and National Patriots Day for Quebec. The 22nd is National Maritime Day. The 25th is Memorial Day. The Indianapolis 500 is run at the end of the month. Being from Indiana, I just had to mention that.

Looks like there is plenty to keep us busy this month.

So, do you remember what May Day is all about? Do you have your maypole ready? How about your May Day baskets? The first day of May is probably just an ordinary day for you and your family, but for centuries, many cultures have celebrated May Day as the first day of summer, even though May 1st comes near the start of spring. It is a time for saying goodbye to the long, cold winter and welcoming warmer weather by gathering flowers, singing, dancing and well, flirting. Early celebrations such as Beltane in ancient Ireland and Scotland and the festival of Floralia in Rome were intended to improve crop growth and to help livestock produce more offspring. Later they became occasions for people to get together and have fun in the sun.

May Day traditions include the crowning of a May queen (and sometimes king) to oversee the day's activities. Children and grown ups might fill May baskets with candy or flowers and secretly leave them on neighbor's porches. People were told that if they went outside early on May 1 and washed their face with dew, their skin would be more beautiful.

Probably the best known May Day activity is the maypole dance. In olden days, people would dance around a pole cut from a birch tree, holding the end of a ribbon or streamer in their hand. The other end of the ribbon was attached to the top of the pole, and dancers moving in patterns around the pole wove the ribbons into colorful designs. That festivity continues in some places in Europe and the United States, though the pole usually comes not from a live tree but from the hardware store. She's the person that corrected me when I was bad.


She's the one that made me happy, not sad.

A daughter is someone who messes up so bad she feels that her world has come to an end; but there is another one built for her


by her mother.

A Mother is someone who always, whether good or bad, stands by her daughter.





POOL AND PET OWNER REMINDERS

FYI: Riviera Estates MHP would like to remind our residents that **NO one is allowed to touch the temperature settings on the pool heater and/or the clubhouse air conditioner. Our manager and the Homeowner's Association Executive Board have insisted on this. Pool hours are 9:00 a.m. until dusk daily. Pool is heated in winter, the months of November through March.**

ATTENTION PET OWNERS: Please be a responsible pet owner and a **RESPECTIBLE** pet owner as well. When walking your pets, please do not allow them to "potty" in other people's yards. Some are not pet lovers as we are.

Your dogs must be leashed at all times, and there are plenty of areas where your dog can go. There is a pet cleanup station in the storage field for your use.

Please be sure to **clean up** after your pet. Also, please try to keep your pet from barking or making loud disturbing noise that can bother a neighbor.

Complaints are being received by the office on a constant basis of pet problems in the park. So, at this time, our pet rule policy should be noted. Pets are allowed in park, *UP TO 20 POUNDS* weight restriction. Copies of pet innoculation certificate must be givien to the office as proof the pet has been vaccinated. There is a *LIMIT OF TWO PETS PER COACH*. Fences for the pets are not allowed to be installed. All pets must be leased at all times when outside the coach. Make certain when you leave your pet, they are not barking the entire time you are gone and bothering your neighbors. If this is the case, please make some type of arrangements that will alter this situation, such as a pet sitter, taking pet with you, or if the problem continues, and complaints continue in the office from residents being bothered by the barking, the park is forced to take steps in resolving the issue, such as requiring you to get rid of the dog, or face eviction procedures. Please be a responsible pet owner and obey the rules concerning




