

ACTIVITIES AND REMINDERS

Reminders:

Pool: The rules are posted at the pool, however, a review is needed to keep the pool safe and fun for all. Please do not touch the "heater" settings, this is controlled by management. No glass bottles/drinking glasses, etc. When you leave, please be courteous and roll the umbrellas down so they will not be damanged if a wind/storm comes up. If you see them up, and no one is in the pool, please put them down. They are expensive to continually replace. No pets are allowed in the pool area. Be sure to rinse off before getting into the pool to keep from allowing oil/lotion etc. Into the pool water. Do not allow grand children to swim unattended. Jumping and splashing is not received well by many swimmers. Review the rules and make sure you are abiding by them.

Clubhouse: The clubhouse is not a storm shelter of any kind. Also, grandchildren should not be in the clubhouse unattended. There is a free library, please return books when you are finished with them. Unfortuately, the cabinets, refrigerator etc. Are locked as we kept having things mysteriously disappear. If you need to have them unlocked for use of a private party. See an officer of the good neighbors for list of who have keys. Be sure to lock all up when you leave. The clubhouse can be used for private parties. There is a calendar posted on the board and if you need to use the clubhouse for a family/private gathering, list it on the date with your name and time needed. We have many wonderful parties in the clubhouse and the bulletin boards is where you learn what is coming up and sign up if you are interested. Be sure when you leave, if the clubhouse is empty, turn off the lights etc. Make certain stove/oven are turned off

Speed: The speed in the park is to be 15 mph. Even though this is a senior park, there are guests and grandchildren visiting. They like to play outside, ride bikes, etc. A speeding vehicle is an accident waiting to happen. Please also tell your guests/family to respect the speed limit. Don't be surprised if you are yelled at by a resident to slow down if you are going too fast. Signs are posted so please be aware of your speed.

Pets: This is a pet friendly park with certain rules. It is required that you be a responsible pet owner. Cats are considered to be "inside" pets and are not to be running free all over the park. If you have a dog, please pick up after them. There is a pet disposal station in the rv lot. Do not allow your dog to use yards to do their business in. Some homeowners are not pet lovers and do not want them in their yards doing their business. Please use your own yard or the rv lot. It is important that we are respectful so we can continue to enjoy our dogs and not cause any anxiety with non-pet residents.

eeping your bones in good shape is vital to your health as you grow older, especially for women. Research reported on the Medical News Today website suggests that women may be able to keep their bones strong by running just one minute a day.

Examining data from more than 2,500 women, researchers found that women who participated in high-intensity, weight-bearing physical activity like running 60-120 seconds a day had 4 percent better bone health than women who took part in less than a minute of physical activity. Women who performed more than two minutes of exercise had 6 percent better bone health.

The researchers cautioned, though, that they can't be sure whether highintensity exercise leads to better bone health, or whether people with better bone health tend to exercise more

New findings about the solar system intrigue scientists

ur solar system is full of interesting places—maybe not to live or even visit, but locations where life might flourish under the right conditions, or may once have been present. Two recent examples from the Science News website:

• Life on Titan? Scientists have discovered that the atmosphere of Saturn's moon Titan contains vinyl cyanide—a molecule that forms membrane-like structures and could support life. Computer simulations suggest the molecule is capable of forming flexible bubbles known as azotosomes, that could serve as an outer shell "protecting" genetic material from biochemical reactions in the moon's frigid

methane seas. No one knows whether azotosomes actually exist on Titan, though. A probe would have to check out the seas to detect them

• Water on Venus? With a surface temperature of 460 degrees, Venus is too hot to support water or life as we know it, but scientists speculate it might not always have been so inhospitable. The second planet's slow rotation—116 Earth days for a single Venusian day—might have led to a gradual cloud buildup in its atmosphere some 750 million years ago, bringing surface temperatures down to approximately 15 degrees Celsius—enough for the formation of a shallow ocean. What happened to the oceans, or whether they even existed, isn't clear. Scientists speculate they may have boiled away or been absorbed into the planet's interior.
