The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone. Use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and wellbeing of everyone, please do not go in the hot tub or pool if you are not feeling well, have wounds or open sores.
