

Home Site Alterations

I f you are making any changes or additions to your home site or the exterior of your home, please come to the office and submit a completed request (green sheet). Paint colors must be approved and a request form must be approved. Submit your written request and wait until you have received approval before proceeding with any work. Anyone other than the homeowner working on the home must be licensed and insured and we must have a copy of such on file in the office.

Guests

dditional guests staying overnight in the park must be registered and paid for. Cost is \$5 per person per night, \$20 per person per week and \$60 per person per month. Residents must accompany their guests while at the pool or other locations and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool.

- The U.S. Congress established Independence Day as an unpaid holiday for federal emplovees in 1870. It became a federal paid holiday in 1931.


