Manager's Corner for April 2015

• When Violation letters are sent to residents, most reference Rule #2 of Serendipity's Rules and Regulations. Included here is the entirety of that Rule: "Each mobile home owner must keep his home, lot and driveway neat and orderly and well maintained at all times. This is to mean that homes shall be painted, with the roof and gutters cleaned. Property must be maintained by weeding, removing debris and fallen fruit. Trees and shrubs must be pruned and driveways must be maintained. Seasonal residents must make arrangements for their yard care while they are gone. No unregistered vehicles shall be parked anywhere within the park. A small table and chairs and a barbeque are permitted in the driveway. No storage is permitted under mobile homes unless the area is neatly screened from view. Screening must be approved by the park before installation. No storage is allowed on the patio or driveway. Lawn mowing and edging is included as part of the monthly rental or maintenance fee. Fertilizing, spraying, insecticide application and watering is the responsibility of the homeowner." There are a number of areas covered in this Rule as it is the most all inclusive of any of the current 36 Rule and Regulations of the Park. If you have any questions about this rule or any of the others, or would like a copy of all the Rules of the Park, please contact the Park Office. They are also posted in both of the Clubhouses.

- As you receive this, the fencing between Serendipity and Riviera should be completed. The five walk through gates that you may come across are for use only in an emergency, and are lined up with the location of the five fire hydrants on Ceylon for entrance and exit by the fire department. These are not to be opened except if needed. The main drive thru gate will continue to be opened for bingo or any other event being held where participation by both communities is apparent (such as March's Fashion Show).
- Stay alert, especially at night as there has been a coyote or two spotted in the area of the power lines.
- I am still seeing a number of homes without updated decals. If the county identifies this, a possible fine can be very costly, so please get your decal updated.
- A new home is scheduled to be placed at lot 97, and if all goes as planned, will be in the Park and set up during the third week of April.
- Both the West Clubhouse Renovation Committee and the Rules and Regulations Committee are making very good and rapid progress on their respective projects. It is anticipated that updates to the Rules and Regulations will be reviewed by the entire Board at a ROC Board meeting before summer.
- Be careful when walking, especially in the evening.
- For all of those who are heading back north in April, we hope that your stay at Serendipity was an enjoyable one, and wish you great health and wellbeing until your return in the fall.

I 'm sure just about everyone has enjoyed putting together a jigsaw puzzle. The definition of a jigsaw puzzle is that it is a tiling puzzle that requires the assembly of interlocking pieces. The pieces are usually oddly shaped. Once put together, it forms a picture.

The jigsaw puzzle was originally created by painting a picture on a flat piece of wood. It was then cut into small pieces with a jigsaw, hence the name. John Spilsbury (London cartog-rapher/engraver) is credited with commercializing the jigsaw puzzle around 1760. They were originally on wood but later (1800s) were made of cardboard.

The variety of pictures on the puzzles is countless but castles and mountains were two of the traditional subjects. You can even order a puzzle made from your personal photograph. Some people like to glue the completed puzzle to a backing and use it as artwork.

Most modern jigsaw puzzles are made out of cardboard because it is cheaper to mass-produce. After the picture is glued to the cardboard, the board is fed into a press. The press forces a set of hardened steel blades (of the desired shape) through the board until it is fully cut. It's sort of like making cookies with a cookie cutter. A typical 1000-piece puzzle requires a press that can generate upwards of 700 tons of force to push the knives of the puzzle die through the board.


In the 1930s, jigsaw puzzles were cut using a large hydraulic press, costing in the hundreds of thousands of dollars. The cuts gave a very snug fit, but the cost limited puzzle manufacture to very large corporations. Recent roller press designs achieve the same effect at a lower cost. By the early 1960s, Tower Press was the world's largest maker of jigsaw puzzles.

Like most everything, new technology has affected the jigsaw puzzle industry. Laser-cutting has enabled puzzles to be made of acrylic or wood. With the laser, the puzzle can be custom cut to any size, shape and any number of pieces.

During the great depression, jigsaw puzzles soared in popularity because they provided a cheap form of entertainment. During this time, jigsaw puzzles became more complex and more appealing to adults.

The puzzles usually come in 300, 500, 750 or 1,000 piece sizes. The largest commercial puzzle has 32,256 pieces. There are also three-dimensional jigsaw puzzles.

Some of these are made of wood or Styrofoam and the puzzle must be solved in a certain order. Puzzle boxes are also common; simple three-dimensional jigsaw puzzles with a small drawer or box in the center for storage. Another type of puzzle is the 3-D "puzzle globe." These are in a single layer but the final foam is a three-dimensional shape. These spherical shapes may be of





the earth or moon. There are even computer versions of jigsaw puzzles.

Jigsaw puzzles can be addicting! This is not a bad thing. It's better than watching inane TV shows or playing the all-pervading computer games. Besides, it's good for your brain!

Did You Know?

- More people in the U.S. enjoy jigsaw puzzles than any other table game.
- The most expensive jigsaw puzzles are made out of wood.
- A skilled craftsman can cut up to 100 pieces per hour but 25-50 pieces per hour are the usual.
- The most expensive puzzles are made by the Stave Company of America. In 1993, a Stave puzzle was sold for over \$12,000. They sell many puzzles each year for prices of over \$5,000 each.
- According to experts, the fastest way to do a jigsaw is to sort all the different colors into groups before you begin. Some experts even stand up the whole time.
- A 1,000-piece puzzle will take about 30-60 minutes to sort the pieces by colors and to separate the straight-edge pieces.
- Why does it take four times as long to do a 1,000 piece puzzle than it takes to do a 500 piece puzzle? When you double the number of pieces, you quadruple the difficulty.
- Puzzle-makers are constantly developing ways to make the puzzle more difficult. For example, putting a fake corner piece in the middle of the puzzle or "color line cutting" (a piece cut exactly along the dividing line between different colors).
- A puzzled containing 209,250 pieces holds the record for a single puzzle.


