#### Manager's Corner for June,2016

- June 1st (other than being my daughter's birthday) is also the beginning of Hurricane Season. As such, the bulk of this report will involve some suggestions, recommendations and requirements for you to be prepared just in case a major storm is headed our way.
- First of all, make certain that all items are removed from your driveway and yard area that could be lifted by the strong winds that accompany a major storm.
- Next, here is a list of shelters that you can go to if your decide to do so, or if you are required to do so:

o Dunedin Community Center, 1920 Pinehurst Rd. Dunedin o Dunedin Highland Middle School, 70 Patricia Ave., Dunedin o Dunedin Elementary School, 900 Union St. N. Dunedin o Palm Harbor Middle School, 1800 Tampa Rd. Palm Harbor o Palm Harbor University High School, 1900 Omaha St. Palm Harbor

- Some other tips include the following:
  - o Make certain that you have a week's supply of water, food and your medications o Have a first aid kit along with a flashlight and a battery operated radio
  - o Have the use of a cell phone so you can communicate with family and friends
  - o Make certain you inventory your property, review your insurance policy and keep important information in a waterproof container that you can take with you if you do evacuate
- One other important note, **under Florida Statute 252.38** you could be charged with a second degree misdemeanor if there is a mandatory evacuation and you refuse to leave, so please leave the Park if you are told to do so.
- There has not been a hurricane in this area for decades, but it is always best to be prepared just in case. Hopefully, this will be another mild weather event season.
- On other matters, Danny's Tree Service will be here in either June or early July to trim the Palms again and to take care of any other tree issues. Please contact the Office if you feel a tree needs to be addressed. There still are a number of fruit trees for example that may be dying and will need removal and these are areas that Danny's will handle.
- There are no major in house projects currently being scheduled, but that doesn't mean there is a lull in what is being done in your community. Expect to see some more sidewalk repairs taken care of by your maintenance staff during the summer. As for other projects, expect to see the West Clubhouse, Office and Pump room at the Pool to be painted in the next few months. There also will be some repair work to be done at the East Clubhouse roof in order to make certain that there are no long term water issues.
- Once again, just a reminder that I am doing home inspections on a constant basis, so please keep your home cleaned and painted when needed, weeds pulled from your flowerbed and the flower bed well maintained, bushes cut below the roof level of your home, backyard kept clean and free of clutter, etc. Let me know if you have any questions regarding this particular subject.



- Please note that the blue dumpsters next to the Serendipity shed on the south side of Imperial is not to be used as a receptacle for large pieces of furniture or mattresses. If you have any of these types of items, please contact the Office and we will either make a call for you or provide you with a name and number of someone who will pick these up for you.
- Have a fun start to summer as another season has just flown by again.



#### The Internet spreads across the globe

A ccess to the Internet has expanded around the world, according to the Pew Research Center. A global survey found that 54 percent of people in the developing world consider themselves "Internet users" in 2015, up from 45 percent just two years earlier. Those users include 37 percent of survey respondents who said they own a smartphone, an increase from 21 percent in 2013.



Still, growth is slow in some parts of the world. In Africa, the countries Burkina Faso, Uganda, and Ethiopia have Internet use rates below 20 percent. The rate is 42 percent in South Africa and 39 percent of Nigeria, two of Africa's largest economies.

Meanwhile, advanced economies have much higher rates—94 percent in South Korea, 93 percent in Australia, 90 percent in Canada, 89 percent in the United States, and 89 percent in the United Kingdom.

#### Figuring the tip: How much to leave?

Where you are to tip a server depends to some extent on where you are. The national average is 18.9 percent, according to the Zagat website, but the amount fluctuates around the country:

## Teach children or grandchildren this important skill

Problem solving is a skill that's valuable throughout your children's lives, from school to their adult careers. You can teach your children how to tackle any problem they're facing by sharing these steps:

- Identify the problem. This is the most important step, and often the most overlooked. Your child can't solve a problem until he or she can state what it is.
- Come up with a list of solutions. Brainstorm possible solutions, even ones that initially seem farfetched. Just keep the ideas flowing.
- Assess each idea. Now is the time to evaluate the merits of each idea, weighing the pros and cons thoroughly.
- Pick one or two ideas. Have your child pick the top two solutions and give his or her specific reasons for choosing those possible solutions.
- Put the decision into action. Before going forward, talk about possible outcomes. What are the potential obstacles? What help can you expect? How can you avoid traps?
- Evaluate and learn. How did the solution work? What changes need to be made to make it work better? What would your child try the next time?



# **Did Neanderthals build their own fires?**

Ur Neanderthal ancestors may have used chemistry to start fires, according to an article on the Scientific American website. Archeologists have found chunks of black manganese oxides in Neanderthal sites for years. Previously they believed the oxides were used for dark body paint, although other sources like ash and charcoal would have been more easily available to them.

flammable than other types of manganese. Groundup particles of the substances can lower the ignition temperature of wood by more than 100 degrees—suggesting that instead of relying on naturally occurring fires sparked by lightning, Neanderthals were able to build fires on their own.

### Radio bursts detected from neutron star

They're not signals from an advanced alien civilization, but they've been a mystery to astronomers for years. Fast radio bursts, or FRBs, are bursts of energy from outer space lasting just milliseconds but emitting as much energy as the sun produces in 10,000



years. Only 17 have ever been recorded, all of them apparently one-time events.

But a repeating FRB has recently been detected, according to the Sci-News website: Astronomers from McGill University using the Arecibo radio telescope in Puerto Rico have recorded a series of 10 FRBs they believe may emanate from a rotating neutron star in a distant galaxy.

This conflicts with previous theories that FRBs are caused by cataclysmic events such as supernovas or the creation of black holes. Whatever their origin, the truth is out there.
