Manager's Corner for September, 2016

- By the time you receive this, new automatic double doors should be installed at the East Clubhouse. These are very similar to the ones that were included in the West Clubhouse renovation last year.
- Serendipity ROC is in the process of purchasing another home and placing it on the lot at #156, Ceylon. This home should be in the Park no later than the end of September and once everything is in place, will be put up for sale.
- As far as other projects in the works, there are none that I would deem as major. The Park is still looking to make changes in the laundry room and that should be coming in the not too distant future, but
- Also by the time you receive this, I was scheduled to attend a public hearing regarding the US 19 road project that is scheduled to commence sometime in the next few years or so. I would guess at this point that the effect it will have on Serendipity will probably only include a lot of inconvenience in entering and exiting the property, and the mess a project like this generates. However, I will update everyone in the October issue exactly what information I receive from this meeting. In the meantime, I would suggest that any of the overly dramatized rumors which I'm sure will go around the Park be taken as just that, a rumor.
- The Park has possession of 1 home at this time, #95, so if you are interested or you might know someone who is looking at a handyman special, this might be an ideal home. If there is interest, just let me know.
- Another home that should be coming on the market hopefully sometime in late September is the home at lot #212.
- Be aware that September can be a very wet and stormy month, so it is very important that you stay alert for any oncoming weather conditions, and as of this writing, the schools in Pinellas County are now open. As such, there is now an increase in traffic on the highways, so please, as always be vigilant when you are leaving the Park and driving on the already over congested roads in this area.
- Be safe and enjoy the soon to be cooler weather!.





After living in Serendipity Park for 36 years, G. Irene (Malcolm) Bassett passed away July 26, 2016 at Florida Hospital North Pinellas in Tarpon Springs, Florida due to cardiac arrest. She was 94 years of age.

Irene was born in Elmira, New York on April 21, 1922. She met her first husband Mark (Todd) Malcolm on a train in Washington, D. C. They were headed back to their hometown in New York State. Dunkle in Mechanicsburg, Pa. Irene also leaves behind her grandkids Todd, Craig, Daniel, Katie, Sarah and two great grandkids D.J. and Kali.

Irene loved her cat "Niner". He passed away last year at 21 years old. Irene's morning always started with her coffee, grapefruit and doing the crosswords in the Tampa Bay Times. She loved to watch the "Wheel of Fortune" and "America's Funniest Videos" on TV. She was an avid reader and seamstress. She enjoyed her pralines and cream ice cream most every night. She was famous for her potato salad and her apple and rhubarb pies. Irene continued to golf and bowl and she loved taking care of her yard and gardens. Pulling weeds was her favorite pastime.

Irene is leaving behind many wonderful friends and relatives who she enjoyed spending time and going out to dinner with. The family appreciates all the cards, food and kind words.



MUSHROOMS NEWBURG

1 ½ LBS. MED. MUSHROOMS ¼ CUP CHOPPED ONION ¼ CUP BUTTER 3 TBS. SHERRY OR WINE

SAUCE:

3 TBS BUTTER 2 TBS WATER

2 TBS FLOUR SALT

2 CUPS LIGHT CREAM CAYENNE PEPPER

2 EGG YOLKS NUTMEG

TOAST OR TOAST TIPS

Melt ¼ cup butter until it bubbles. Add mushroom & onion. Saute until almost tender while you prepare the sauce. Add sherry or wine and simmer for 1 or 2 minutes.

Sauce: Heat 2 tbs. butter and combine it with the flour to make a roux. Add the heated cream and stir with a whisk until it thickens. Beat the egg yolks with the 2 tbs. water and blend into the white sauce. Pour the sauce over the mushrooms in the pan and stir it well. Season with salt, a little grated nutmeg and just a touch of cayenne pepper if you wish. Serve immediately, hot over toast or toast tips. Serves 4-6 people. Enjoy!

Protect food from spoilage—and yourself from getting sick

oes something smell foul inside your refrigerator? It may be food gone bad. Two kinds of bacteria that can spoil food: pathogenic bacteria, which causes foodborne illness; and spoilage bacteria, which causes food to smell, taste, and look bad. Keep these tips in mind for storing food safely:

- Watch the temperature. Bacteria grow the fastest between temperatures of 40 degrees Fahrenheit and 140 degrees Fahrenheit. A refrigerator set at 40 degrees Fahrenheit or lower will protect most foods.
- Eat or refrigerate promptly. Don't eat food that's been stored at temperatures above 40 degrees Fahrenheit for longer than two hours.
- Don't let foods dry out. Cover foods or wrap them in plastic to retain moisture.
- Divide up. Divide large dishes, like stew or soup, into small portions and put them in shallow containers before you refrigerate them.
- Use the meat and vegetable drawers. They provide the optimal storage environment for these types of foods.
- Eat promptly. A general rule of thumb for cooked leftovers is to toss after four days; one to two days for raw poultry and meats.



The cephalopods are coming

on't look now, but cephalopods are on the rise. A team of scientists have determined that cephalopods—sea-dwellers including mollusks, squid, cuttlefish, and octopuses—are increasing their numbers below the waves.

As reported on the Sci-News website, scientists at the University of Adelaide created a database of catch rates for 35 species of cephalopods from 1953 to 2013. They found that cephalopod populations have increased across three distinct groups since the 1950s.

The sea creatures are able to adapt to environmental changes quickly due to their short lifespans, rapid growth, and life-history plasticity. Their growing numbers could have both positive and negative effects: increased pressure on the undersea species they hunt for prey, but also benefits for marine predators who in turn hunt them, as well as humans who harvest them from the sea for food



Chinese brewed beer in ancient times

rafts beers are thriving these days, but beer has been around for a long time, scientists say. Researchers in the United States and China have revealed that the Chinese brewed their own beer some 5,000 years ago, much earlier than previously believed.

As reported on the Voice of America website, archaeologists have uncovered brewing equipment in underground rooms in China's central plain region. Traces of ingredients found on the equipment suggests that the ancient brewmasters used a recipe of broomcorn millet, barley, a grain called Job's tears or Chinese pearl barley, and a form of tuber to brew their beverage. The presence of barley 1,000 years before it was believed to have been grown in China suggests that it might have been brought in from other regions, making beer an ingredient in early trade.

Researchers describe the possible taste of the beer as "a bit sour and a bit sweet."


