# **HOA President's UPDATES**

oping everyone is holding up, staying healthy and safe. I am saddened when I listen to the news and hear what's going on in our world today. I

L look forward to returning to our community this fall if the numbers are good, travel is not restricted, and it seems safe.

At the time I'm submitting this article, ELS will not let the HOA sponsor any activities. I hope it has changed by the time you read this. Both clubhouses are open and you are welcome to use them in small groups to play cards or just get together. Please wear masks! Please wipe down tables and chairs before you leave the clubhouse.

#### Summary of HOA Board meeting with ELS Property Manager (Penny Garcia) August 5,2020

• Mailboxes were to start a few weeks ago and I think residents should be comfortable with the mail service by this time. Delivery should have started about August 15. Asking the











residents to keep their mailboxes on their house for any notices from the HOA or ELS. The letters we received from ELS explains the rules and information about the mail changes.

- The lawn service contract was awarded to a new vendor. At this time I did not get a start date but let's cross our fingers they are there and doing a good job.
- 360 Inspections will resume shortly. ELS can now send warning letters to residents who haven't complied to notices from 360 inspections or not following rules and regulations. If you don't correct the infraction you will then get a 7 day letter and if you do not comply you will be sent to the legal department. When courts reopen you will go to court and you will have attorney fees. Easier to comply.
- You can not drop off your rent payment at the office. Please mail your rent checks or go online to the portal to pay. This is safer for everyone so there is less contact and traffic at the office.
- Filters in the air handling systems are now being changed monthly and a company will be inspecting them to be sure they are safe and operating as they should.
- There are no new reports that owners of pets are not following the rules. Let's hope this continues.
- Vegetable gardens have been removed and a tree service will be removing the fruit trees. This is an effort to keep the rats under control. If you have bird feeders it would be beneficial to remove those also.
- Furniture for the East clubhouse is expected to come soon.
- Entrance landscaping: ELS had all dead plants removed and when there is funding they will replace the plants they had to remove.
- Penny is following up on all reports of unauthorized guests and renting rooms.
- There were no reports of smoking or drinking at the pools.
- Capacity at pool is increased for numbers in the water but chairs are the same. We asked for some regular chairs to replace the comfort height furniture.

Any concerns and complaints should be shared with ELS management. If you don't let them know about an issue, they can not fix it. Appointments are needed to go to the office.

Be safe and enjoy the beginning of the fall season.- Pat

#### **MANDARIN ORANGE SALAD**

#### Ingredients:

- 1 large can crushed pineapple undrained
- 1 pkg vanilla instant pudding (sugar free)
- •2 cans mandarin oranges drained
- •1 pkg (8 oz) cool whip (light or fat free)
- •1 cup coconut (optional)

#### **Directions:**

- Mix cool whip ant dry pudding mix together
- •Add pineapple and oranges plus coconut (if desired)
- Refrigerate a minimum of 3 hours until it thickens
- Top with mandarin oranges

**MANDARIN ORANGE CAKE** 

#### **Ingredients:**

- •1 box yellow cake mix
- •1 cup water
- •2-3 eggs
- 1/3 cup oil
- •1 can mandarin oranges
- Topping: 1 can crushed pineapple, 1 box vanilla instant pudding, 1 container cool whip

#### **Directions:**

- Whip above ingredients together and pour into 2 layer cake pans and bake according to package directions
- When cool, add topping and use between layers on cake
- •Add 4 mandarin oranges on top



#### THE CURIOSITY CORNER

R<sup>ats!</sup> It is quite natural to feel disgust with the possibility of sharing your dwelling with a nest of rodents. More human diseases that have severely impacted the human race, have originated from rodents

than any other animal. They seem to like the same foods that we eat. They contaminate our homes and may even present fire hazards as they gnaw into wall electrical wires. Pest control specialists generally divide the Florida rat population into three species.

The Roof Rat is the most common rat found in Florida homes, often referred to a Fruit or Citrus Rat. They will nest in trees, woodpiles, garbage and plants but prefer high places like the roof especially inside attics and wall spaces. These rats will eat anything readily available but tend to be vegetarian. They will chew through lead and plastic pipes to reach water. Roof rats tend to hoard food to be eaten later. They're known for hollowing out citrus fruit in trees or on the ground. They can grow over a foot long, usually have smooth brown or black fur, big ears and eyes, and capable of producing over 20 additional rats a year. They have a life span of up to three years. They often can go unnoticed until the neighborhood fruit begins to ripen. In citrus, papaya, cantaloupe and watermelon they burrow into the fruit hollowing it out leaving a quarter or half dollar size hole in the skin. In apples, peaches, tomatoes, bananas and pineapples large sections of the fruit is eaten away.

The Norway Rat (Sewer Rat) usually resides outdoors but may venture into your home in

search of food and will eat anything from meat to grains. These rats are a burrowing rodent, usually about 8 inches long with a blunt nose and small eyes and ears. Their fur is course and shaggy with a short scaly tail. They're usually found in close proximity to human habitats. They may burrow under foundations, into crawl spaces, or other structures, around ponds, in garbage dumps, sewers, or other locations where food and shelter are present. Norway rats are an aggressive, primarily nocturnal specie and will usually drive other rats away. They have an average lifespan of one ear and are capable of producing over 20 offspring a year.

The Wood Rat, (Pack Rat) is usually the same size as the Norway rat. It is the least common of the three rats mentioned and usually found in Northern Florida. It has a hamster type look, long, soft, fine fur with furry tails. They range from black or gray to brown in color. They can become an issue because, besides eating food and leaving droppings around, the wood rat is known for stealing small items, hence the nickname Pack Rat.

Then to be fair we should not leave out the smaller version of this rodent. **The House Mouse** is the most common rodent. They originate outside but enjoy taking up residence inside wall spaces, basements and attics. They are about half the size of a rat, with a body length usually about three to four inches. They have soft gray or brown fur with a white under belly and have dark whiskers. The mouse can be so stealthy that you may only become aware of their presence by their droppings around or in your home. A mouse is capable of producing 35 little mice a year.

#### Suggested practices to help keep rats away:

Remove food and water sources, and store food for people and pets in sealed containers.

Clear property of debris and other materials were rodents may hide.

Do not leave out pet food, give just enough for its meal.

Put pet food away after use and do not leave pet-food or water bowls out overnight. Keep bird feeders away from the house and use squirrel guards to prevent rodents'access to the feeder.

Remember that rodents are capable of spreading 35 different diseases through direct contact with the rodent or their feces, urine, saliva, bites or from insects that previously fed on the rodent.

Do rats have natural predators? Ye-e-s-s. Many kinds of snakes will prey on rats; the yellow rat snake, gray rat snake, black racer, king snake, and indigo snake to name a few and many venomous snakes as well. Raptors, hawks and owls are also quite effective at killing rats. Cats and dogs will not keep the roof rat or rat population under control. Cats may have a slight affect upon the juvenile rat population but is more than likely unable to kill a mature roof rat.

Man has often removed what was thought to be a pest only to realize that it was a natural predator of the new pest. So it's advisable to try and look at the larger picture before giving in to one's impulse to eradicate a disgusting creature, although admittedly sometimes that's quite difficult to practice. It may be advisable to think twice and resist the urge to pound that snake several inches into the ground.

There are companies pedaling ultrasound and electromagnetic devices with claims of being able to repel rodents, insects or other pests from buildings and yards. There is NO scientific evidence at the present time that these devices work. Several independent sources have conducted studies on many of these products and their description of these items; worthless, or a shocking waste of money. One review concluded that some might have a temporary effect on insects but they seem to realize that the sound isn't lethal and return. The Federal Trade Commission and



Environmental Protection Agency has brought suit against several companies in the past for false advertising, and demanded an end to their advertising campaign, until proof was submitted that their product worked. It's recommended to research the product before you decide to try one to help solve your insect or rodent problem.

The St. Petersburg Sanitation Department offers a Rodent Line at 727-893-7360 or 7398 for citizens to report rats on their property. They will come out to place a trap in an appropriate place outside your residence, and instruct you on various ways to help resolve your rat problem for free. If you have undesired four legged creatures in your home however, you will have to call a professional pest control company.
