Just a few items – first, please pick up after your pets, there has been dog poop in the street. That is nasty, please remember if you do not follow the pet rules we will ask your pet to leave the park.

Second, all checks must be in the office by the 10th of the month no later than 4:30 so I can post them and you will not get a late fee. They have not started the new procedure for sending checks to Tampa as yet so please continue to pay them at the office until further notice.

Third, please do not purchase another home in this community until you check with the office first. We will need a new application signed and a new proof of income for the other home, we do not charge for this nor do we rerun credit but your application must be updated. If you are trying to sell your home and have already purchased another do not forget you are responsible for two lot rents on both homes until one is sold. We do not take title turn-ins!!!

Fourth, unauthorized occupants are not allowed. An unauthorized oc-cupant is someone who stays with you past the two week visiting period. If you wish them to stay longer, and they are age qualified, they need to have a criminal background check.

Lastly, please do not throw mattresses in the dumpsters unless you cut them up (this goes for furniture also). The trash company will charge the park extra and this charge is passed onto the residents

Always be proud of your home; keep it clean, pressure-washed, and painted, driveways clear of clutter and your yard not overgrown with weeds.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Dr. Pepper Salad

Submitted by Helen DellaPenna

- 16 oz. can pitted black cherries drain reserve juice
- 8 oz. can crushed pineapple drain reserve juice
- (2) 3 oz. boxes cherry Jello
- 1 ½ cups Dr. Pepper

Heat cherry & pineapple juice, stir in Jello until dissolved. Add Dr. Pepper, cherries, pineapple, and pecans or walnuts (if desired). Pour into mold and chill until firm.

Citrus Garlic Shrimp

- ½ cup olive or vegetable oil
- ½ cup orange juice
- 1/3 cup lemon juice
- 3 to 4 garlic cloves, minced
- 5 teaspoons grated lemon peel
- 4 teaspoons grated orange peel
- 1 teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon pepper
- 1 package (1 lb) linguine
- 1 lb. uncooked medium shrimp, peeled and deveined
- Shredded parmesan cheese
- Minced fresh parsley

In a blender or food processor, combine the first eight ingredients; cover and process until blended. Pour into a large skillet; heat through. Meanwhile, cook linguine according to package directions. Add shrimp to garlic mixture; cook for 5 minutes or until shrimp turn pink. Thicken if desired. Drain linguine; top with shrimp. Sprinkle with parmesan cheese and parsley. Yield: 6 servings





RECYCLING

ongratulations to the residents of Shangri-La MHP for your efforts in supporting the recycling program of Largo, FL. We have been recycling so much that we graduated from smaller blue bins to a larger dumpster.



One phone call to Marissa Sugundo resulted in getting the small bins, often over-flowing, removed and one large dumpster installed. To make it easier, no separation is required; so paper, steel and aluminum cans, glass and other containers can be put into the same bin (but, please, no plastic bags).

At certain functions at the Club House, we will have a smaller container, so we encourage you to divert "good stuff" from the garbage bin into the blue recycling box which will be emptied into the appropriate dumpster.

If we all work together we can make the world a better place, one can at a time.

EARLY RISER VS. NIGHTHAWK: WHO'S BETTER OFF?

Are you the early bird who gets the worm, or a night owl burning the midnight oil? The answer may have an impact on your health—and even your career.

One study cited in U.S. News & World Report found that teens who are early to bed and early to rise tend to be in better health than their peers who stay up late and sleep in, even if they get the same amount of sleep. And other studies suggest that morning people do better at resisting fatigue, anxiety, and depression, while nighthawks appear to suffer higher rates of insomnia and ADHD. The stay-up-late crowd may also have a higher propensity for substance abuse, addictive behaviors, and mental health problems.

But being a night owl has its advantages, too. Research also indicates that they can have higher IQs, more stamina during the day, better reasoning and analytical skills, and greater creativity and productivity. These traits, along with an inclination toward more risk-taking, seem to contribute to night owls having a higher average level of financial and career success.

The Mayo Clinic website notes that our sleeping habits are governed by the body's natural 24-hour cycle, known as the circadian rhythm. Some people have a slightly longer light-to-dark ratio, making them night owls; others with a short cycle tend to be early risers. However, the cycle can shift over a person's lifetime: Young children are usually early birds, then become nighthawks as teenagers, then gradually transition back to being morning people as adults.
