
PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dressing (make ahead)


- 1/2 cup light olive oil





DWARF STARS NOT CONDUCIVE TO EXTRATERRESTRIAL LIFE



The search for planets capable of supporting life may have hit a speed bump. The most common exoplanets discovered up to now tend to orbit close to low-mass stars, known as M dwarfs. These planets may be plentiful (or at least easier for astronomers to find), but computer simulations suggest that their proximity to these suns causes their water and atmosphere to burn away while they're forming.

Stars are created in the collapse of interstellar gas, producing energy as they shrink. M dwarfs, having less mass, take longer to develop and remain very hot as their planets solidify, creating conditions that can boil oceans and turn atmospheres to steam. In addition, M dwarfs emit lots of ultraviolet light and X-rays, which also heat upper atmospheres, forcing them to expand and ultimately bleed away from the world.

So tomorrow's star explorers may have to look for different destinations as they journey out into the universe.




