Holiday Happenings

Tuly received its name in order to honor the Roman dictator Julius Caesar (100 B.C.—44 B.C.). With the help of Sosigenes, Caesar developed the precursor to the Gregorian calendar we use today.

- July 1 is **Canada Day**, a Canadian federal holiday that celebrates the creation of the Dominion of Canada in 1867. The Dominion of Canada was a union of the three separate Canadian colonies of the time—New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, and Canada (which included Quebec and Ontario). Canada remained a part of the British Empire until 1982.
- On July 3, the hot and sultry **Dog Days of Summer** begin!
- July 4: **Independence Day (U.S.)** on the fourth of July celebrates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence in 1776. Don't forget to raise the flag!
- July 14 is <u>Bastille Day</u>, which commemorates the storming of the Bastille and the start of the French Revolution.

Did You Know? John Adams believed that July 2 would be the day when Americans would celebrate their independence. On July 3, 1776, he wrote to his wife, Abigail: "The second day of July, 1776, will be the most memorable epocha in the history of America. I am apt to believe that it will be celebrated by succeeding generations as the great anniversary festival."

July Birth Flower

July's birth flowers are the **larkspur** and **water lily.** The larkspur, especially white forms, generally indicates lightheartedness; pink, fickleness; purple, first love. The water lily symbolizes purity of heart.

July Birthstone

- he July birthstone is the ruby, which is believed to protect its wearer from evil.

 "Ruby" is derived from the Latin rubeus, which means "red."

 This gem is a red form of corundum; all other colors are sapphires. The ruby's color is due to the presence of chromium, which also makes the gem subject to cracks. High-quality rubies are a transparent, vibrant, purplish red; cloudier samples, or ones containing brown, orange, or pink tones, are less valuable. Many rubies nowadays are heat-treated to improve color saturation and transparency.
 - The ruby, along with the related sapphire, are the second hardest natural gemstones, with only the diamond being harder.
 - The gem was once thought to protect warriors if worn on their armor or embedded in their skin.
 - Considered the king of gems, the ruby symbolizes love, passion, energy, and success.

This Month in History

WE DO DECLARE!

n April 19, 1775, during the Battles of Lexington and Concord (Mass.), the first shots were fired between colonists and British troops, starting the American Revolution. After these first military conflicts, tension between Britain and her American colonists continued to mount. Finally, on July 2, 1776, the Second Continental Congress voted for independence from Britain.

Two days later, on July 4, the Congress approved the final draft of the Declaration of Independence, which had been written by Thomas Jefferson and edited by John Adams and Benjamin Franklin. On July 8, the first public reading of the Declaration took place at the Pennsylvania State House (now Independence Hall) in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Later that




same day, other readings occurred in Trenton, New Jersey, and Easton, Pennsylvania.

Printer John Dunlap made about 200 copies of the Declaration dated July 4. Known as the "Dunlap Broadsides," these were distributed throughout the 13 colonies. However, it wasn't until August 2 that the Declaration was officially signed. John Hancock, president of the Congress, was the first of 56 delegates who signed this enlarged version, writing in big, bold letters.

Let's try something in crochet for this month

Crocheted Stash Buster Basket Materials:

- 2 balls Red Heart Super Saver yarn
- 6.5 mm [US K-10 $\frac{1}{2}$] crochet hook
- Yarn Needle



Instructions:

For a bigger basket, continue round 5, just increase an additional dc in each round (so the next round would be ch 2, 2 dc in first st, dc in next 4 sts). For a smaller one, omit round 5. You can also make the basket walls as high as you'd like by continuing or halting rounds when you get to round 7.

This pattern requires holding two strands of yarn. Ch 2 does NOT count as a st. Ch 4 does count as dc and ch 1.

- 1. With 2 strands of yarn held together, ch 4, sl st in first ch to create ring.
- 2. Round 1: Ch 2, 12 dc in ring, join with sl st to first dc. (12 dc)
- 3. Round 2: Ch 2, 3 dc in each st around, join with sl st to first dc. (24 dc)
- 4. Round 3: Ch 2, (2 dc in first st, dc in next st) 12 times, join with sl st to first dc. (36 dc)
- 5. Round 4: Ch 2, (2 dc in first st, dc in next 2 stitches) 12 times, join with sl st to first dc. (48 dc)
- 6. Round 5: Ch 2, (2 dc in first st, dc in next 3 sts) 12 times, join with sl st to first dc. (60 dc)
- 7. Round 6: Chain 4, dc in first st, sk 1 st, (V-st, sk 1 st) 29 times, join in 3rd ch of ch-4. (30 V-st)
- 8. Rounds 7-15: SI st into first ch 1, ch 4, dc in same ch 1, (V-st in next ch 1) 29 times, join in 3rd ch of ch 4. (30 V-st) if you want your basket to be higher, you can continue this for five more rounds, for a total of 20. I thought 15 was plenty for me.
- 9. Round 16: Ch 3 dc in each dc from previous round, join in top of ch 3.
- 10. Weave in ends.

Grilled Chicken and Herb-Cheese Wraps

Ingredients

1 carton (8 ounces) nonfat plain yogurt

1 tablespoon wasabi powder

4 flour tortillas (9-inch)

1/2 cup garlic-and-herb-flavored cheese spread, softened

Grilled Chicken Breasts (below), cut into thin strips

1 avocado, peeled, seeded, and sliced

1 carton (4 ounces) alfalfa sprouts

1/2 cup shredded carrots

Instructions

Stir together yogurt and wasabi; cover and chill. Grill flour tortillas. Spread cheese evenly over tortillas; top with chicken, avocado, and sprouts. Roll up and cut into slices. Top with shredded carrots. Serve with wasabi sauce.

Grilled Chicken Breasts Ingredients

1 lemon, diced and seeded

1/4 cup olive oil

1/2 tablespoon minced garlic

1/2 tablespoon minced shallot

1/2 teaspoon chopped fresh oregano

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon pepper

2 large chicken breast halves, skinned and boned

Recipes

Instructions

Process first seven ingredients in a blender until smooth, stopping to scrape down sides. Place chicken in a shallow dish or heavy-duty zip-top plastic bag. Pour marinade over chicken. Cover or seal; chill 1 hour, turning occasionally. Remove chicken from marinade; discard marinade. Grill chicken, covered with grill lid, over medium-high heat (350 degrees F to 400 degrees F) about 10 minutes on each side or until done. Cool slightly and cut into thin strips.

1 cup milk


Homemade Whipped Cream, recipe follows

2 cups whipping cream, chilled in the fridge

4 tablespoons sugar



1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F.



Homemade Whipped Cream:

Yield: 4 cups

1. Chill a large metal mixing bowl and the wire beater attachment in the freezer for about 20 minutes. Pour the chilled cream and sugar into the cold mixing bowl and beat until it forms soft peaks, about 5 minutes. The mixture should hold its shape when dropped from a spoon. Don't overbeat or you'll have sweetened butter!

Cook's Note

If you don't have self-rising flour, substitute 1 cup all-purpose flour mixed with 1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder and 1/8 teaspoon salt






