And it is hard to overlook the many negative comments from numerous Kingsley park residents from across the country. I will always wish I could have done better.

My job of president has been so rewarding only because of the dedication and support of the many board members that have given freely of their time and talents for so many years. And my sincere thanks go to you, the residents, who without you, we would be just another non-functional homeowner's association. I'm not going away, for the Board has asked me to stay on as a member during this transition time. So stay tuned, for I am sure new leadership will lead your representation to new and thrilling heights.





## **Cranberry Sauce: Good for What Ails You**

According to www.wpi.edu/news/cranberrysauce

When it comes to health benefits, this Holiday favorite condiment takes center stage. In fact, researchers at WPI (in Worcester, MA) have found that compounds in cranberries are able to alter E. coli bacteria, which are responsible for a host of human illnesses (from kidney infections to gastroenteritis to tooth decay), in ways that render them unable to initiate an infection.

Research findings show:

- The chemical changes caused by cranberry juice create an energy barrier that keeps the bacteria from getting close to the urinary tract lining.
- Direct measurements show that the adhesive forces between E. coli and cells of the urinary tract are greatly reduced when at least a 5 percent solution of cranberry juice cocktail is present.
- Cranberry juice causes tiny tendrils (known as fimbriae) on the surface of the type of E. coli bacteria responsible for the most serious types of UTIs to become compressed, reducing the bacteria's ability to latch onto the lining of the urinary tract.
- E. coli grown in cranberry juice or the isolated PACs are unable to form biofilms. Biofilms, clusters containing high concentrations of bacteria, are required for infections to develop.
- When E. coli are cultured over extended periods in solutions containing various concentrations of either cranberry juice or PACs, their cell membranes undergo changes that hinder the bacteria's ability to attach to cells of the urinary tract.

So, this holiday season, don't spare the cranberry sauce!

- 2 cups diced unpeeled tart apples
- 1/2 cup halved green grapes

### **Ingredients:**

- 1 can (20 oz.) crushed pineapple in juice, undrained
- 2 pkg. (3 oz. each) JELL-O Raspberry Flavor Gelatin
- 1 can (16 oz.) whole berry cranberry sauce
- 2/3 cup chopped PLANTERS Walnuts
- 1 apple, chopped

### **Directions:**

Pour a half cup of dish detergent (degreasing dish detergent like Dawn works best) into the clogged toilet. Follow this with at least four cups of very hot (not boiling water, it may crack the bowl).

Carefully pour the very hot water into the toilet bowl and watch as the soap helps to unclog the toilet. If you're worried about there being too much water in the toilet bowl once you try to flush, turn the water valve off (located behind the toilet close to the floor). The very hot water and degreasers will break up the clog, sending it right through. It might sound crazy, but it actually works!

You may have to wait up to 15 minutes for the clog to work loose. If you don't see any action after that point, you're probably going to need to call a plumber.


