summer camps. Thanks to Young at Heart, foster care children and youths will be able to participate in many of these activities and more.



THINGS TO DO

ou may already be aware of this but for those who have not heard, many previously closed areas and businesses are now allowed to be open. Business employees are required to wear masks and guidelines for proper sanitation and cleaning must be maintained as well as social distancing by customers.



- Area beaches: open for sunbathing, fishing, swimming etc. Practice social distancing
- Largo Golf Course: The snack bar & pro shop remains closed. Call for a tee time.
- Department & Specialty Stores: Some stores such as Beall's, Macy's, Michael's and Olde Tyme Pottery are open. Some may have abbreviated store hours or are delaying their reopening, so be sure to call in advance.
- Restaurants: Are now allowed to have in restaurant seating but are limited to 25% capacity. For some establishments this will not provide enough income to bring in wait staff, so before making plans for dinner out be sure to call first. Restaurants are still doing curb-side pick-up and deliveries.
- Barbershops & Hair Salons: Employees must wear masks & visits should be by appointment only to avoid too many people congregating in a waiting area.
- Nail Salons & Day Spas: Employees must wear masks & visits should be by appointment only to avoid too many people congregating in a waiting area.

FLOWER POWER

Excerpts from United Healthcare & On-line Resources

Thile not all flowers are safe to eat, those that are offer some health benefits. You can use flowers from your own garden if they have not been sprayed with a pesticide or fungicide or from specialty shops that sell herbs or teas.



- LAVENDER: can be added to baked goods and pairs well with chocolate. Lavender tea can help with digestive issues, can help reduce stress and help you sleep. Mix up a batch of Herbes de Provence to season chicken, beef, lamb, fish & salad dressing. There are several varieties of lavender, but you should only use English Lavender in foods.
- ORCHIDS: are most commonly used in cocktails, stir fry dishes, salads and sweets like ice cream and cake. Vanilla, a powerful antioxidant, is actually a member of the orchid family.

- - NASTURTIUM: flowers and leaves can be used in salads, tea or as edible decorations on baked goods. The leaves have a slight peppery taste. Nasturtiums are packed with nutrition, containing high levels of vitamin C, manganese, iron, flavonoids, and beta carotene. They have the ability to improve the immune system, tackle sore throats, coughs, and colds, as well as bacterial and fungal infections.
 - HIBISCUS: flower can be eaten raw, but it has a rather tart flavor. The best use of the flower is to make either hot or iced tea. The flavor is similar to cranberries. By adding fresh mint, lemon grass or basil you can add a new dimension to the taste. The National Institute of Health notes that drinking hibiscus tea may help lower blood pressure and cholesterol.

HERBES de PROVENCE RECIPE:

Mix dried herbs together and store in an air-tight container in a cool dry place:

- 2 TBS Lavender buds
- 2 TBS Basil
- 2 TBS Rosemary
- 2 TBS Savory
- 2 TBS Thyme leaves
- 2 TBS Oregano



HIBISCUS TEA RECIPE: SERVE HOT OR COLD

- 2 Cups fresh hibiscus flowers (or ½ cup dried flowers)
- 8 Cups water
- 1/4 Cup honey (optional or to taste)
- 3 TBS fresh lime juice
 - Prepare flowers by removing the calyx (the green part at the base of the flower) and the pistil (pollen bearing tube in middle of flower).
 - In a large pot bring the hibiscus flowers and water to a boil. Once the water is boiling, remove from heat and cover the pot. (At this point you can add in other flavors such as basil, lemon grass, mint leaves). Let step 15-20 minutes.
 - Stir in honey and lime juice till incorporated. Strain and serve hot or cool in the refrigerator and serve cold.







OUR TRIP HOME

irst, the good news. We are sitting here in Innisfil under 2-week quarantine. Now the details (some of them) since the hell part is quite long.



Apr 7 - fine, 12 hours, stayed in Virginia overnight.

Apr 8 - (6:30a) left Hyatt - ETA Innisfil 6:30p - and headed into the mountains where it started to rain. One of the wiper blades decided it needed a rest. Stopped beside the road for a half-hour of wiper repairs with tools in the car (45 minutes). Had them replaced before we left Largo so not a happy camper.

- still raining. Another wiper blade self destructs, continued driving in the rain (no wipers) until I spotted an Advanced Auto store. Purchased new high-quality blades (guy installed them for me in the rain) and off we go on 4 lane winding (mountains) road, when left front motorcycle tie-down strap broke. Harley now dragging along highway still attached to the trailer but now on its side so quickly stop on the shoulder.
- cut remaining straps so we can get Harley vertical and see the damage. Front lights all broken (main, running light, 2 LED spotlights), both mirrors, helmet lock, one saddlebag catch, cell/GPS holder, sissy bar torn back cushion, handlebars bent. The rollbar on the left side will need to be replaced. It protected the bike but was ground down a lot during the drag portion.
- 2 men stopped to help. They helped get Harley vertical. I got the ramp set up again and started the Harley then got it back on the trailer. The guys helped stabilize it and then left. Used 4 new straps to tie down and departed the scene (1 hour 30 delay). Still raining stopped about another hour later.
- crossed the border after some hassle at Immigration (Canada) but the sticky point was a "Canadian" returning home with 3 vehicles all licensed in FL. Also driver's license. Had evidence of "residence" in Innisfil, Canadian Veteran Card, US passport and expired Canadian passport (1 hour).
- heading north on 400 and the Pontiac Aztek decided it had enough for one day (8:30p). Coasted to shoulder next to Canada's Wonderland and called CAA.
- spent several minutes on phone to CAA then call dropped in mid-conversation. Trying to reconnect with CAA and tow truck arrives. Sort out details and get the car hooked up. Trailer disconnected. He's not CAA and wants cash no credit cards (9:45p)
- arrived by a tow truck (it's raining again). He disconnected and headed back to get the trailer (70k/43M 1 way). and I start unloading the Aztek it's full to the brim.

Apr 9 (our bodies still think it's Apr 8th) - arrived back with trailer/Harley 12:30am

• needed Mazda working to go get money from ATM. Battery flat so boost to get it going



- locked the Mazda (key only no power locks) and walked home in the rain. Arrived (3:05a).
