### **TEAKWOOD RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

Teakwood Mobile Home Association

any of our northern U.S. residents are returning to the Village and we continue to see new faces of people who have recently purchased homes in Teakwood East. If you have not had time to read the park rules in the prospectus or if it has been a long time since you have reviewed them, the TMHA hopes these monthly excerpts will remind you of the rules and regulations we must all follow. It is the responsibility of all residents, whether year-round or seasonal, to abide by the Rules & Regulations found in the Prospectus. This month:

### C. FEES AND CHARGES

1. Rents are payable in advance, due on the first regular business day of the month. All rents must be paid within the first five regular business days of the month. Any monthly rental payments not received by Management by the fifth (5th) business day shall be subject to a late charge in the amount of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) until the tenth (10th) business day of the month. For each day beginning on the eleventh (11th) day of the month, there will be an additional \$5.00 per day delinquency charge for every day the rent is unpaid. All Rents are to be paid at the Rent Collection Office and Sales Office. No rent will be accepted over three (3) months in advance. You are urged to use all the recreational facilities of the park at the invitation of the Park Owner, provided you abide by the rules concerning them. Specific Rules and Regulations as to the use of the various recreational and service facilities are located at each facility and are specifically incorporated herein.

2. Rates apply to no more than two(2) adults per mobile home. There will be a charge of \$1.00 per day for each day a registered Guest stays in a mobile home longer than fifteen (15) consecutive days or more than thirty (30) total days per year. Such charge shall be assessed against the owner of the mobile home within the Guest occupied.

1. If you have a name change, someone moves out of the house or there is a death, please make sure to contact the Main office and provide the proper documents ensuring that Teakwood has proper records. As part of your planning you should make sure that

someone in your family knows to do this in the event you are unable to.

- 2. DO NOT SPEED. I cannot reiterate this enough. The speed limit inside Teakwood Village is 10MPH. Maintain this speed throughout the Park. If you are cited for speeding, you only get one chance. The second notice will state you are not to drive in Teakwood and are subject to eviction.
- 3. Trash and Garbage: Household trash is picked up curbside Mondays and Thursdays between 7AM and 7PM. Furniture is picked up with the household trash on Thursdays. Lawn/tree/bush trimming and weeding must be bagged or bundled and will be picked up with household trash. If you have a lot of trimming or are doing a renovation, contact the main office and request a dumpster. Make sure you are ready for it as we only have 2 and they are in high demand.
- 4. Hazardous Waste: This includes, but is not limited to: TVs, computers and paint. Teakwood does not provide pick up for hazardous waste. You must take it to the Household Electronics & Chemical Collection Center located at 2855-109th Ave N in St Petersburg. There is no cost to individuals. Check the website, pinellascounty.org, for hours and mobile drop-off locations.

Teakwood offices will be closed November 26 & 27 for Thanksgiving. There is no household trash pick-up on Thanksgiving Day, trash will be picked up on Monday the 23rd then the next pick-up is Monday the 30th. Stay safe, stay healthy and stay happy.

Recently, I brought some household items to Joyce & Hugh Austin's home. In the past, Teakwood East residents have donated clothes, linens, toiletries, kitchen and other household items and food to the



Outreach Center @ the Austin's Crossroads Church. Also a couple of people had provided them with peanut butter and jelly sandwiches each week, which were greatly appreciated by the Outreach clients.

Thanks in no small part to Joyce & Hugh, the Crossroads Community Center has managed to stay open every week since the start of the virus, serving their clientele outdoors (as Pinellas County has restrictions regarding the opening of the building at this time). The clients get a bag of food depending on if they have facilities from which to cook... as some do not (they are homeless). Family bags have more food and a bar of soap and a bonus of laundry detergent is added, if available. People are also given razors, deodorant, toothpaste and brushes, combs & brushes and even can openers - which the church buys at The Dollar Tree. In the past, Teakwood East residents would generously donate small hygiene products, as well as regular sized shampoos, conditioners, body washes, moisturizers, etc. These days, there is a need for masks, hand sanitizers, hand soaps, towels & bedding, as well. In only one Wednesday day in October, the Outreach Center was able to give out 46 bags of food, had 11 new people, 5 special requests (homeless) and 6 families. Anyone who would like to visit the Center on a Wed. from 10:00 to 1:00 are more than welcome.



# **VETERAN'S DAY:**

ovember 11th is Veteran's Day. This is a day everyone should take a moment to give thanks to our Veteran's, from all branches, past and present, who have served to protect us, our country and the freedom's we enjoy. It doesn't matter if they served at home or abroad, in war time or in peace...to me, they are all heroes. Here is a story of one veteran:



Staff Sergeant Daniel Acosta (USAF, Ret.) is one of the relatively few wounded veterans who did not serve in the Army or Marine Corps. A native Chicagoan, Dan joined the Air Force right out of high school in 2002 where a combination of natural skills and opportunity led him into a highly charged career path – explosive ordnance disposal. After 11 months of training, Daniel was assigned to the 775th Civil Engineer Squadron at Hill Air Force Base. From there he was dispatched to Iraq in 2006 as a member of the 447th Expeditionary Civil Engineer Squadron. Explosive ordnance disposal specialists were in high demand, then and later. Daniel underwent nearly three weeks additional training in Kuwait before deploying to Sather Air Force Base at Baghdad International Airport. He had been in Iraq performing missions for three months when he was injured.

On December 7, 2006 he was sent to disarm hidden improvised explosive devices (IEDs) and had disarmed two when the third one got him. "I stepped on a pressure plate," he recalled. "It wasn't detected (by the metal detection device) because it was wood." His left arm was blown off in the blast and he received third degree burns to his legs. He also sustained arterial injuries to his leg and heart.

"In the back of my head I always knew something could happen," Daniel said. But he and his fellow airmen on his team had undergone combat life-saving training at Ft. Carson, Colorado, and he attributed that training applied by his teammate Staff Sgt. Joe Upton to his survival. "They (the doctors) gave me a 25 percent chance of living," Daniel said. "They said if I made it through surgery, I would have a 50 percent chance."

Daniel said he has avoided the perils of post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and traumatic brain injury (TBI). "The Veterans Administration rated me a minor case of PTSD. But I accepted the reality of my injury early on. I get around well. The injuries are there, sure, but I am capable of doing a lot. I play different sports. I am enjoying life."

Daniel actively supports other wounded veterans by working closely with the Coalition to Salute America's Heroes. "It is important to wounded veterans to feel that they are part of a larger community," Daniel said. "They want to know the community supports them. The Coalition fills that role and it is an important one."

- And... it's fun! It is not often you can say that about a workout


If you still have any concerns, please check with your physician to see if this would be of benefit to you.



It there Teakwood Village.. it's time for another CURBSIDE DIN-ING review. This month, I'd like to tell you about SONNY'S BBQ. Located 2250 Seminole Blvd, Largo, right before Ulmerton, it's easy to enter, but a bit tricky to exit, due to traffic on Seminole, so be careful. Check out their menu on sonnysbbq. com. You can have your meal delivered for a fee or make a curbside request. (727) 501-9000. My daughter Debbie & I have been there twice during this pandemic! The first visit, in early May, Deb ordered "Pork 3 Ways" for \$17.59. Her meal consisted of pulled pork, sliced pork and sweet & smoky St Louis style ribs. Our second visit was in late August. I had St Louis style ribs this time, with mac & cheese, garlic bread & barbeque beans on the side. Debbie decided to try the brisket this time. My ribs were excellent (as usual) and Deb enjoyed her meal.. she wished she had ordered MORE!! And how about those corn muffins?!! SO GOOD!! That dinner also came to \$43 including a tip. 



#### **RECIPES OF THE MONTH**

A few dessert recipes for the upcoming Thanksgiving celebration.

#### **Queen Elizabeth Cake**

1 egg 1/2 c shortening
1 c. Sugar 1 c boiling water
1 tsp baking soda 1 1/2 c flour
1 tsp baking powder 1/4 tsp salt
1 tsp vanilla 1 c chopped dates

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 & prep a 9 x 13 pan with butter & flour.
- 2. Pour boiling water over chopped dates & baking soda. Let cool while mixing remaining ingredients; add last.
- 3. Blend shortening & sugar. Add egg. Mix flour, baking powder & salt. Add to shortening, sugar & egg mixture.
- 4. When well blended, add date mixture & vanilla. Pour into 9 x 13 pan. Bake 35 min. @ 350.

#### **Cake Frosting**

- 5 Tbsp brown sugar
- 3 Tbsp cream or milk
- 3 Tbsp butter

Boil above for 5 min. Remove from heat & add 1/4 c coconut. Add 1/2 c chopped walnuts or pecans. Do not make frosting until cake has been in the oven for 25 min. When baked, take cake out & spread icing evenly while hot. Return to the oven to brown icing slightly.

#### **Lemon Squares**

This was a very popular square choice when my foods classes catered an event.

1 c. Butter

1/2 c icing sugar Pinch salt 2 c. Flour 4 Tbsp flour

4 eggs 1 tsp. Baking powder 1 1/2 c. Sugar 8 Tbsp lemon juice

- 1. Preheat oven to 350. Line 9 x 13 pan with parchment paper.
- 2. Stir butter, icing sugar & flour together & press into pan. Bake at 350 for 10 min.
- 3. Beat eggs & add remaining ingredients. Pour over cookie base & bake 25 min. longer.
- 4. Sprinkle with icing sugar when cool.

#### Creme Brûlée

Serves 8

1 quart heavy cream (whipping cream)

3/4 c. Granulated Sugar

1 vanilla bean, halved lengthwise & scraped or 1 Tbsp vanilla

8 egg yolks

8 Tsp. brown sugar

Preheat oven to 300.

- 1. In a med saucepan, combine the cream, Granulated sugar, vanilla bean & vanilla bean scrapings. Heat until hot but not boiling, stirring to ensure the sugar is fully dissolved.
- 2. In a separate bowl, whisk the egg yolks & slowly add them to the warm cream mixture, stirring constantly.
- 3. Fill each ramekin (8) & place in a hot water bath. Cover with aluminum foil. Bake 25 min. @ 300 until just set in center. Chill for 3 hours.
- 4. Sprinkle each custard with 1 tsp. brown sugar. Brûlée with a torch or under the broiler & serve immediately.
