The person that called me was concerned because these vendors were very aggressive and she was concerned that some of our seniors might be intimidated into purchasing the meats. In the past a different vendor sold tainted meat. I got there as soon as I could and escorted them out of the park. PLEASE, if you HAVE NOT called these people that come knocking on your door, DO NOT ANSWER THE DOOR. They will try to get you to sign a contract for whatever they are selling and you will be locked into it. BUYER BEWARE.

The Board had a lengthy conversation with John Houle about "pets in the park" John informed the Board that when someone purchases a home, they are given a prospectus and other information on the rules and regulations. The problem being most people either do not read this information or choose to ignore it. If the new owners have pets, they must show proof that the pets are registered with the county and show that the pets have been inoculated before the pets are allowed. The problem is when an owner "rents" out the unit then it falls on the owner to make sure that this policy is addressed. Also, John has to follow state regulations regarding service animals.

If you have a problem with "pets" and want to know if they are in fact registered and have all of their paperwork in order, then you should call Animal Control. They will come and make

hhh, April is here, spring has sprung. Let's find an appropriate topic to mark the change of seasons.

Beauty, aesthetics, cleanliness. That is what we shall talk about this month. Specifically the exterior of your home and your lot. We will be covering most of a section in the Rules and Regulations. See page 5 section H: Mobile Home Lots to follow along.

For the outside of your home, make sure to clean it, either pressure wash or brush and bucket and make sure that you get the bricks/skirting as well. This will keep your house clear of dirt as well as mold/mildew. While you're cleaning the home, also clean the outside of the shed, driveway and sidewalk to keep down on the ickies that might grow there. Safety and health concerns will be lessened this way.

We also have a lot of wind and rain which carries seeds everywhere, so check your flower beds for weeds. We've discussed roof top gardens (a no-no) so make sure to get your gutters cleaned also. I know it sounds like we are just going in about making Teakwood pretty, but there really are health and safety reasons for all of this. Nobody wants to breathe in mildew or walk, and slip, in it. Weeds and debris on roofs and in gutters creates a lovely spot for water to accumulate, extra weight to cause damage to your home and critter homes. Remember Florida has lots of rain, heat and interesting wildlife so taking simple precautions, such as keeping your home clean and tidy, clearing weeds from flower beds and picking up fruit that falls from trees goes a long way to keeping the bad stuff at bay.

nd then it was April! Who amongst us would ever have thought things Leould turn around so quickly? With the pandemic of Covid-19, this past month all of our lives have been turned upside down. As much as I have been taking the stance of "let's all calm down", I now find myself becoming more concerned for our vulnerable population. With so many of our friends in Teakwood being older or having underlying medical conditions, we must practice social distancing while still making sure our friends and neighbors are ok. I am fortunate to have access to medical sites that have the most up to date information and I have been following several blogs from infectious disease specialists. One of the reasons this virus is worse than say a regular Flu virus is that it is new to humans and as such we have no natural immunity. Many of us have had to cut our vaca-



tions short and return home. When we return we must self isolate. This includes not going to grocery stores, so make sure you have someone shop for you. Visiting with family and friends is also discouraged and no visits to restaurants etc. Many restaurants at home have completely closed or are offering take out only. For our American friends, the government websites are the most likely to have information pertinent to the corona virus pandemic. Federal, State, and local websites can keep you up to date. As serious as this is, most of us will likely not even know if we contract the virus as it will be like a bad cold or the "flu". That is why we must stay vigilant. Wash your hands, maintain a safe distance – at least six feet- isolate when told, monitor for elevated temperature – greater than 38' Celsius or 100' Fahrenheit, monitor cough and contact your physician, telehealth or local health unit with questions. Do not visit local emergency departments if you suspect you have the virus unless you are having difficulty breathing.

As scary as this is we shall get through this and hopefully be able to return to our regular lives within the next month or two. Please remember to be kind to those people working in retail.

Stay safe, try to remain calm and God willing we will all be back next winter.



RECIPES OF THE MONTH

SPLIT PEA & HAM SOUP

A hearty soup which makes use of your leftover Easter ham.

- 1 (16 oz) pkg. dried green split peas, sorted & rinsed
- 2 qts water
- 4 Tbsp olive oil
- 2 c. chopped onions
- 2 c. chopped carrots
- 2 c. sliced celery
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 ham bone with leftover meat
- 4 c. cubed ham (or remaining leftovers)
- 2 qts water
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp ground black pepper



- 2. Heat oil in a 4 qt saucepan. Sauté onions, carrots, celery & garlic in oil over med-low heat until tender about 10 min.
- 3. Return the split peas to the saucepan.
- 4. Add ham bone, cubed ham, 2 qts water, salt & pepper. Cover & bring to a boil over med heat, stirring occasionally. Reduce heat & simmer 1 hr. Remove cover & continue simmering until desired thickness, stirring occasionally.
- 5. Remove ham bone; cut off any remaining meat. Dice meat & return to the soup before serving.

Makes 12 - 16 servings
