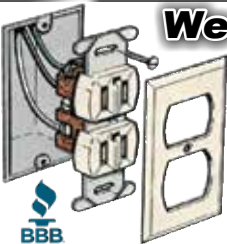

Finally, Duke's last suggestion was to have the Park (West Wind Mobile Home Community) move all the meter poles.

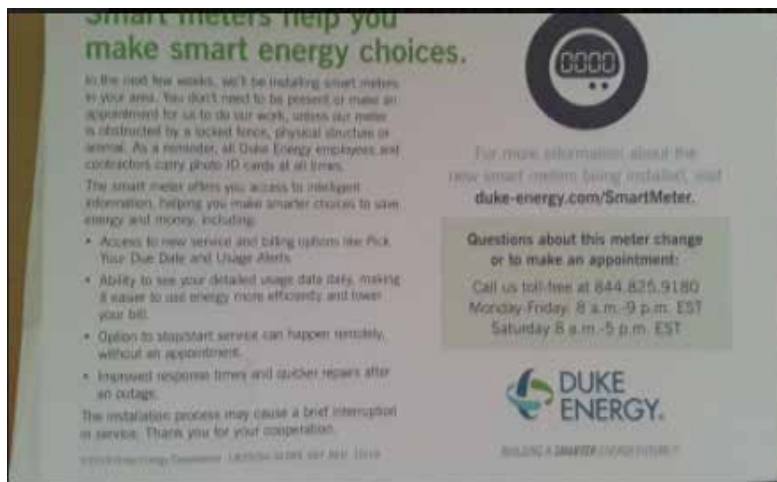
Maybe if we all refuse - they will bypass Westwind I!!.
